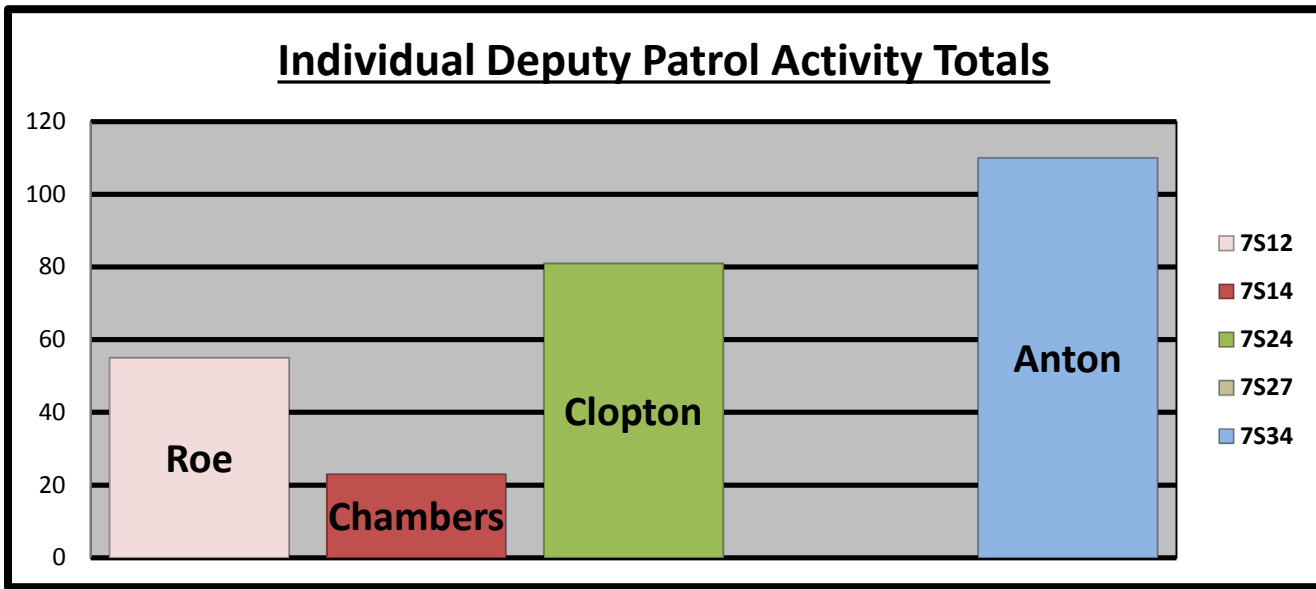

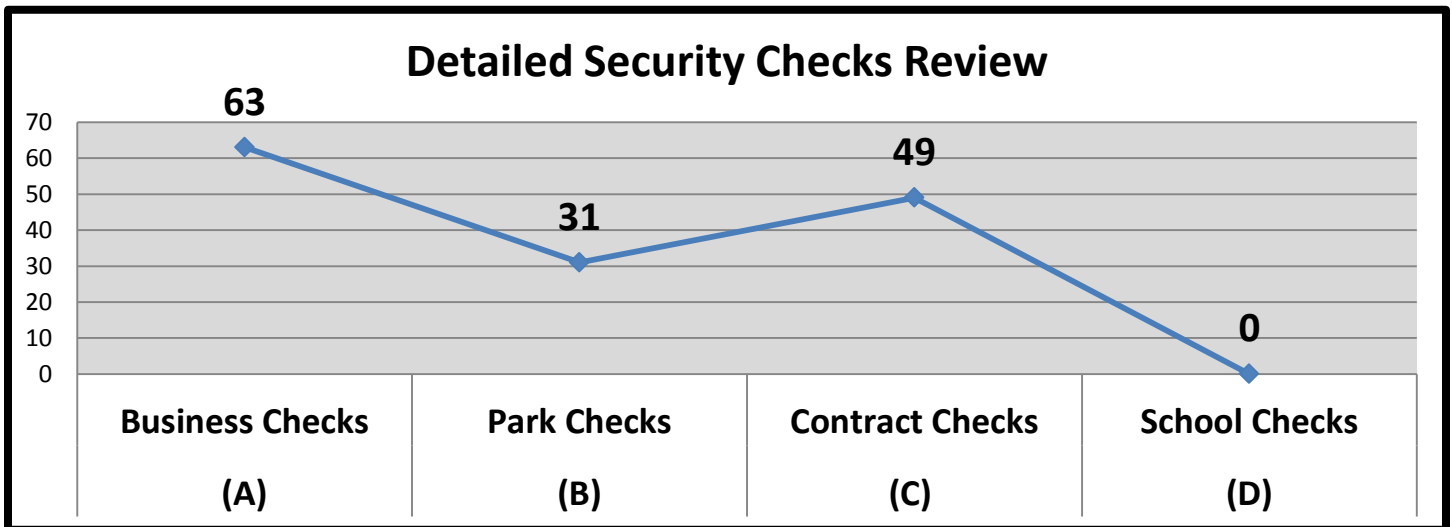

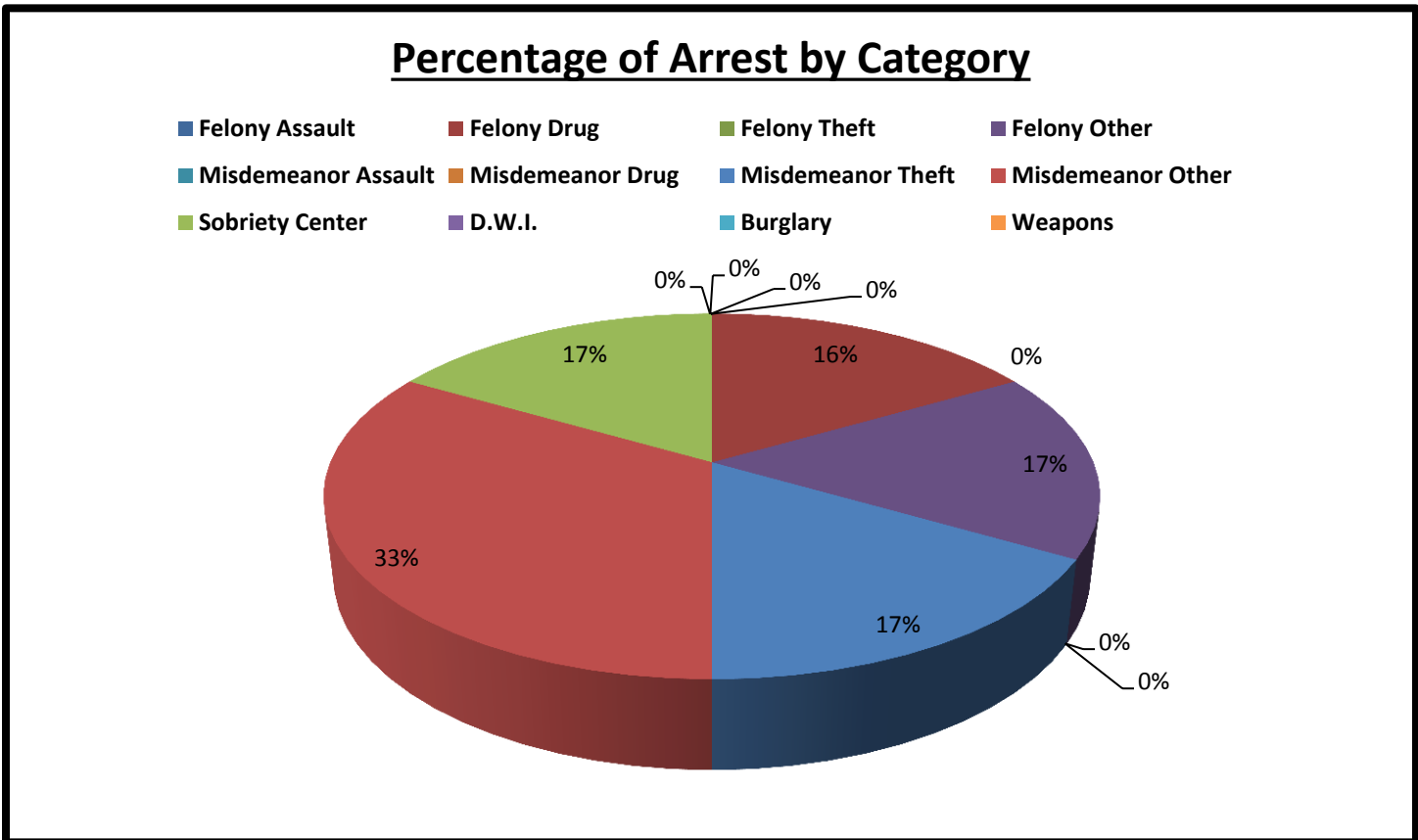

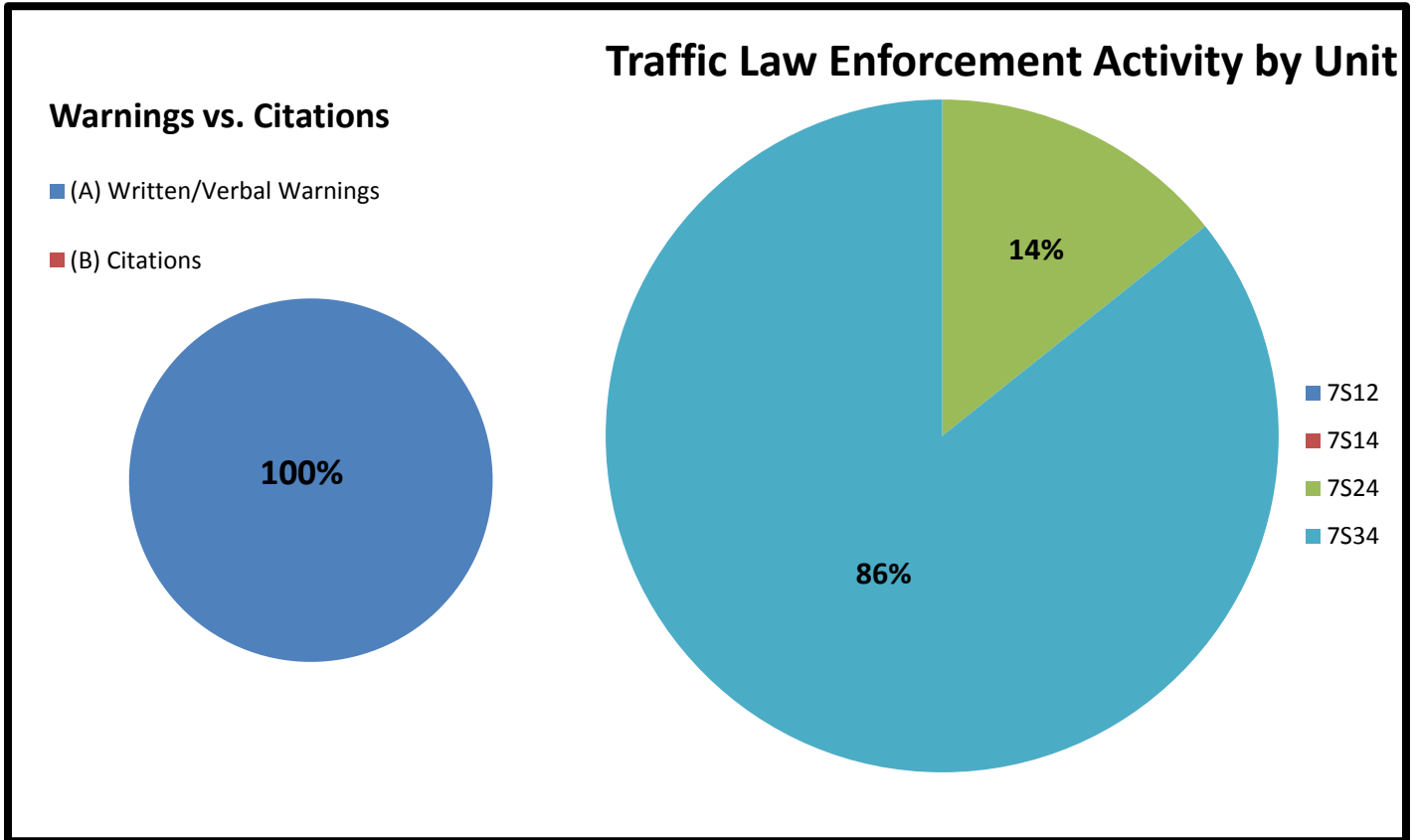

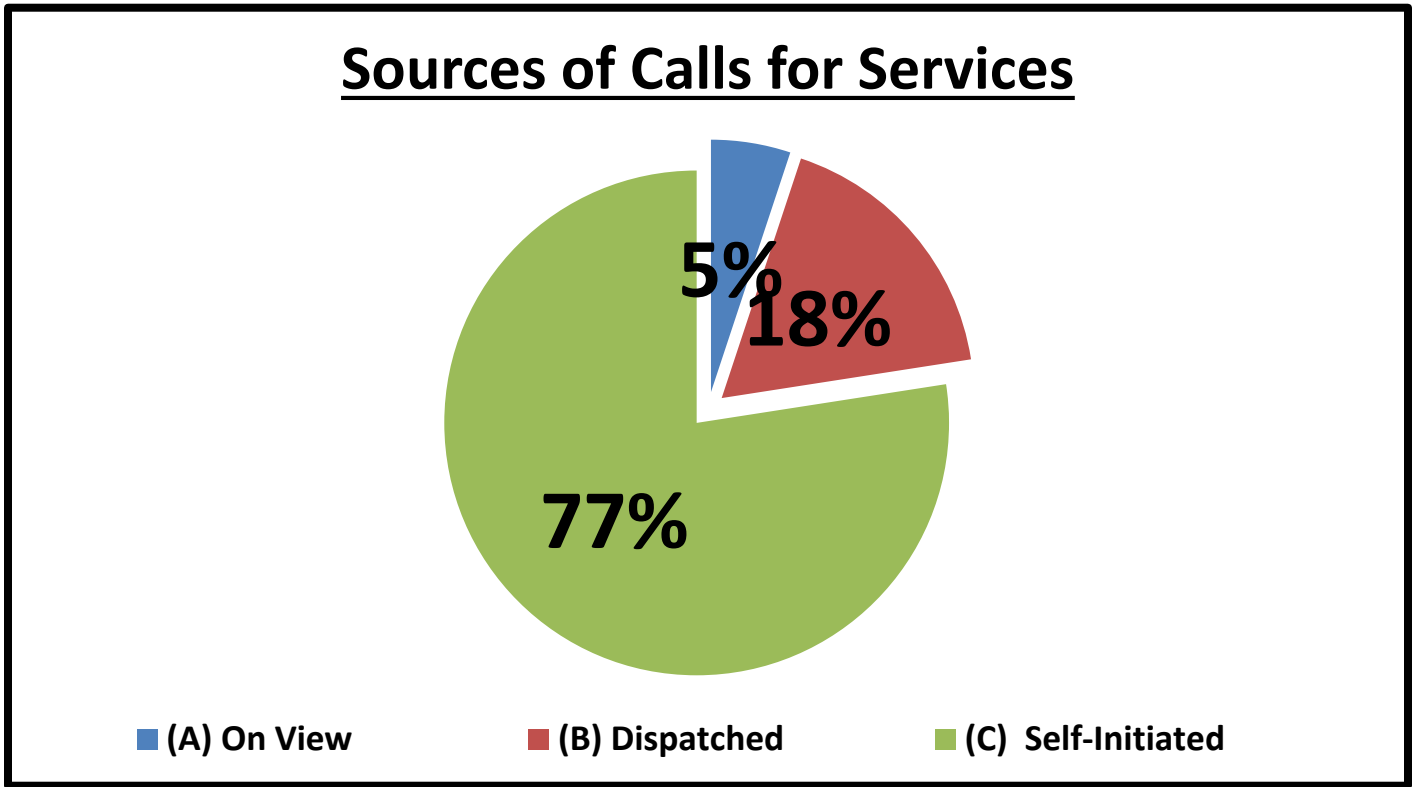
**S. Traffic Law Enforcement Activity Percentages:**
