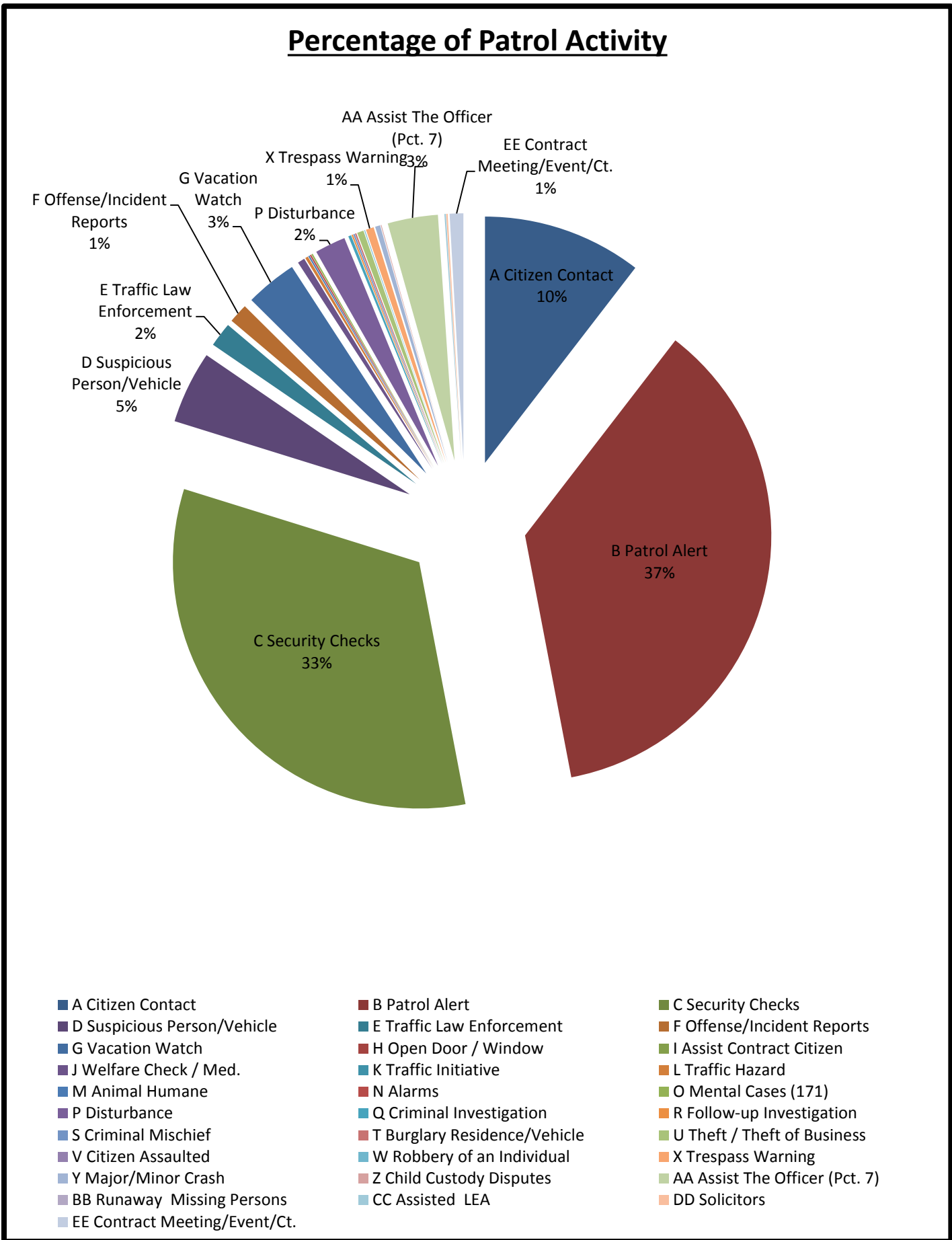

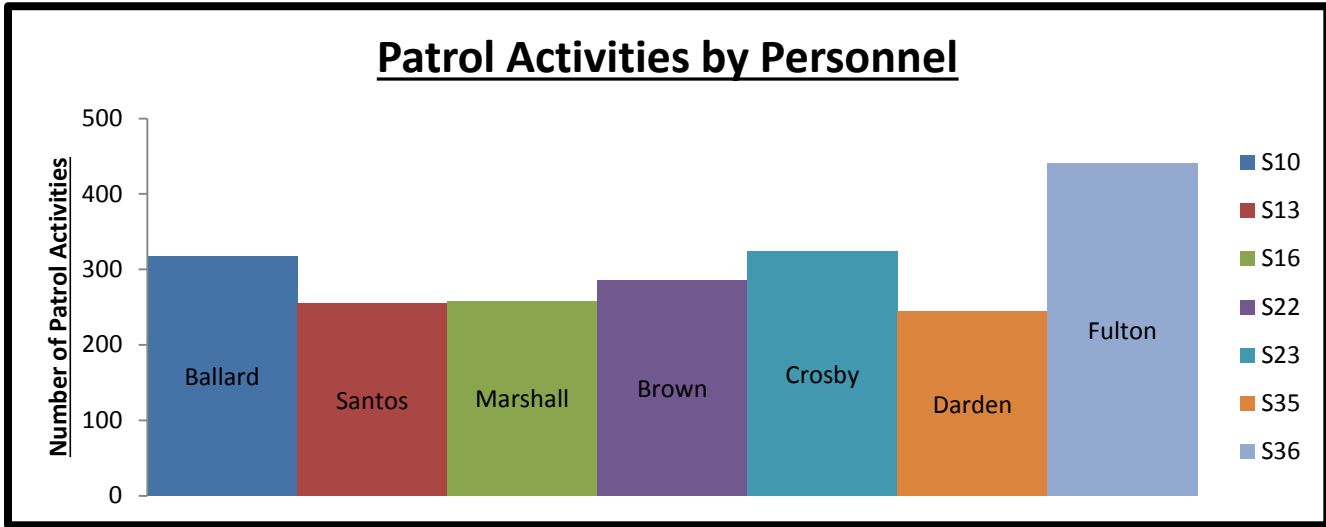

## A2. Patrol Activity by G.S.E.M.D. Personnel:

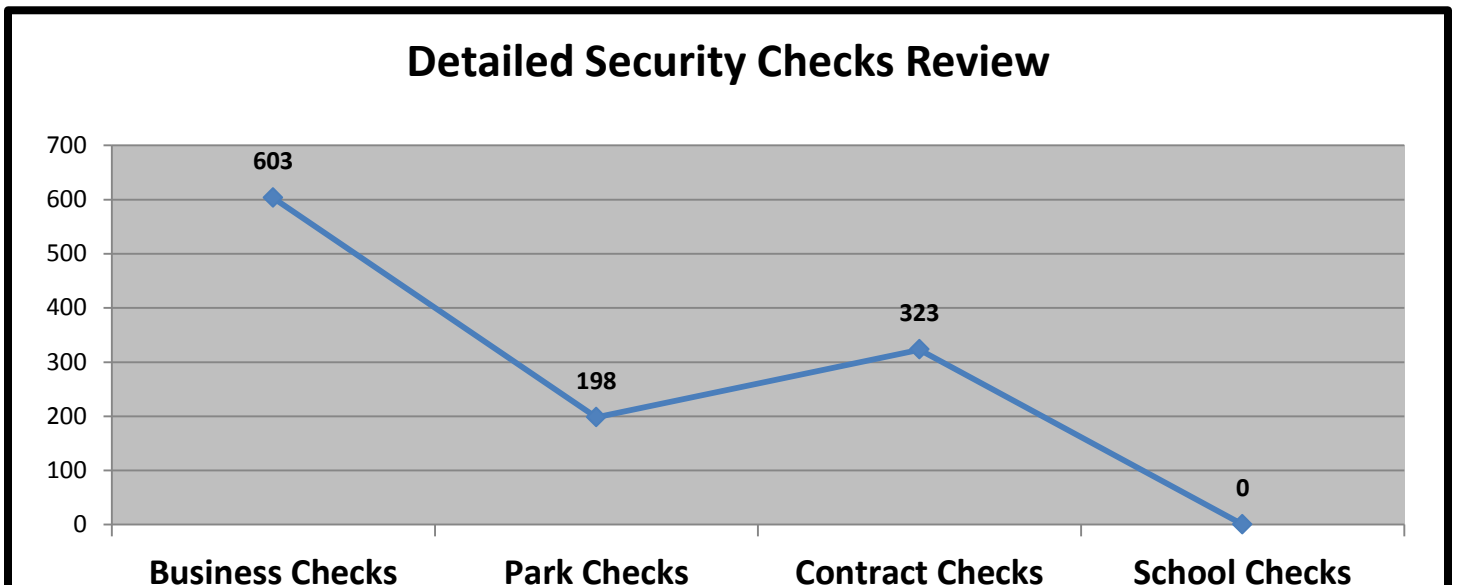

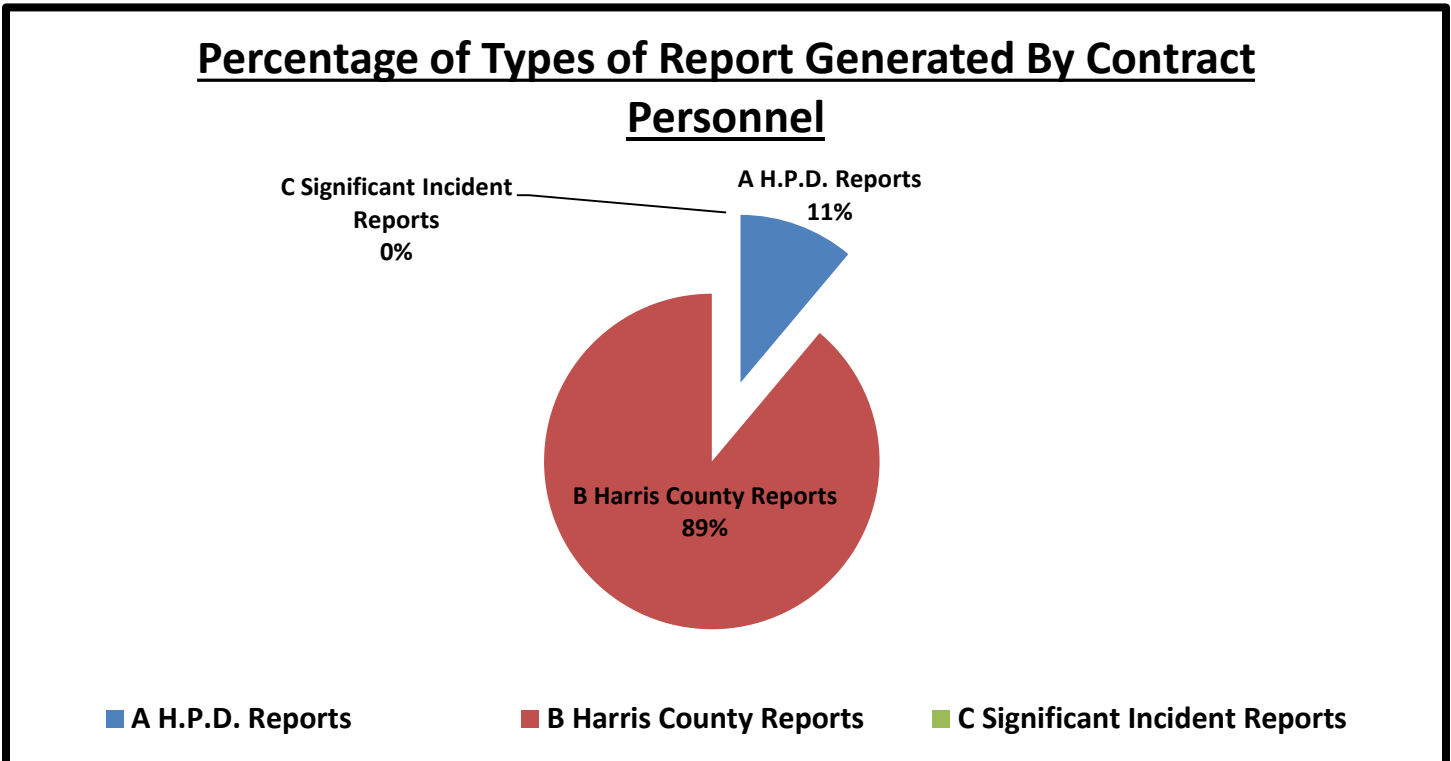

**D1. Report Generation Percentages:**



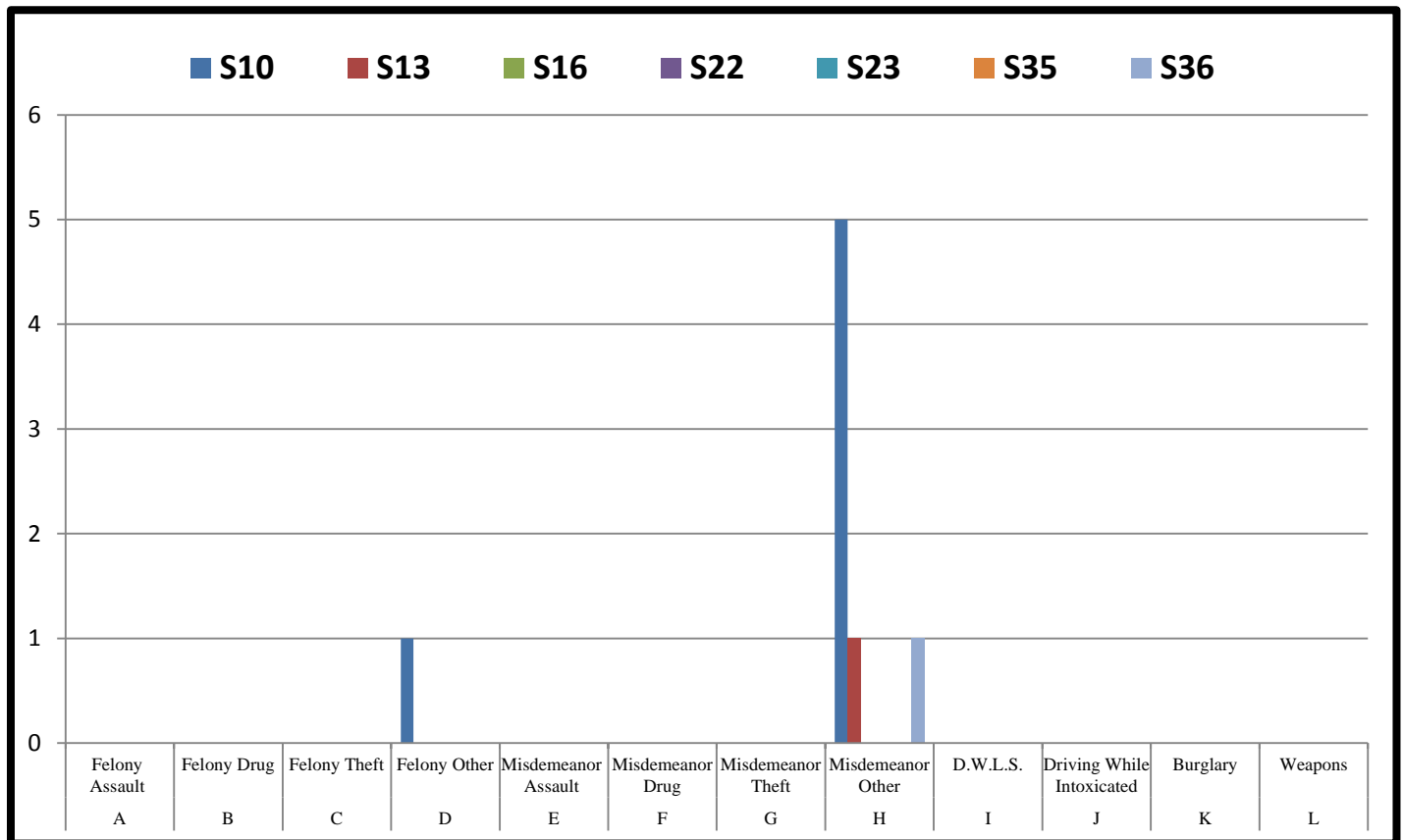

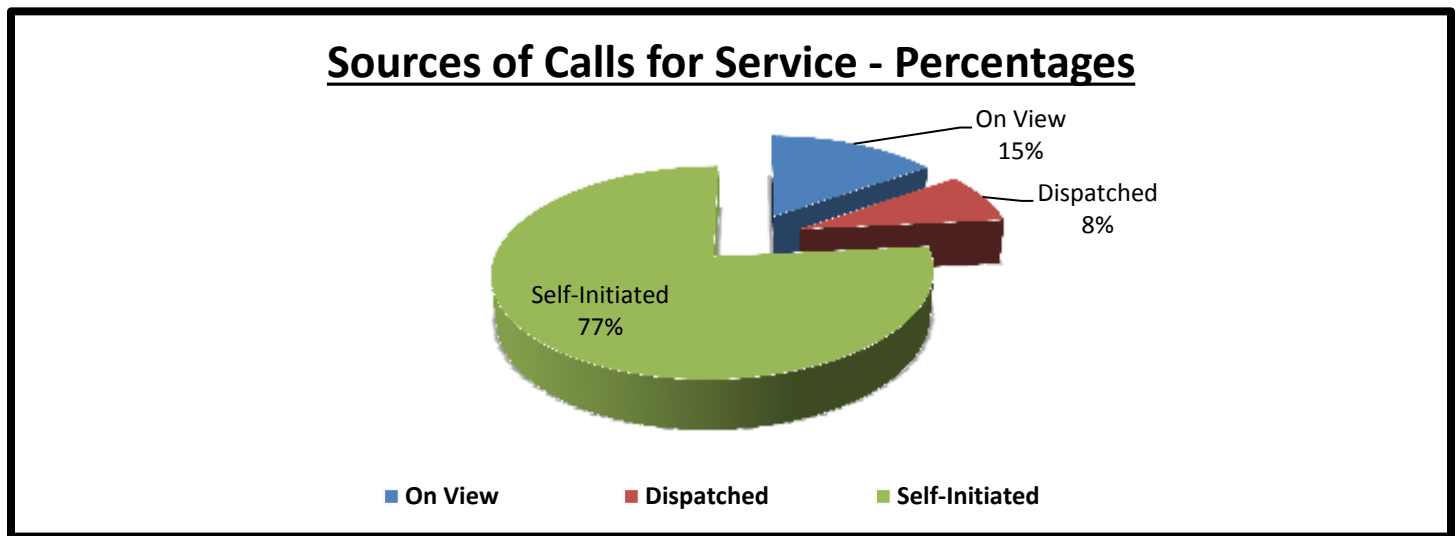
