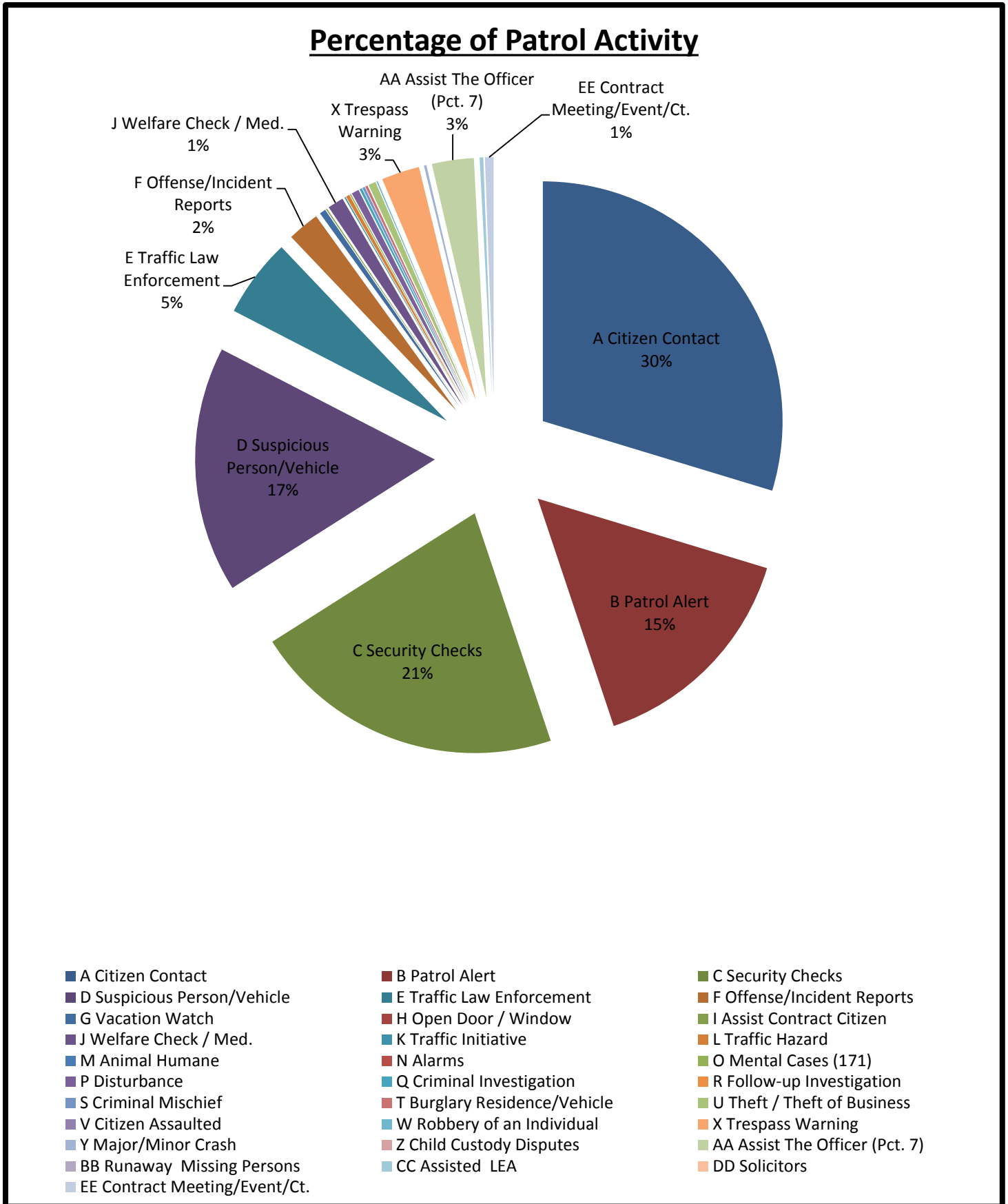

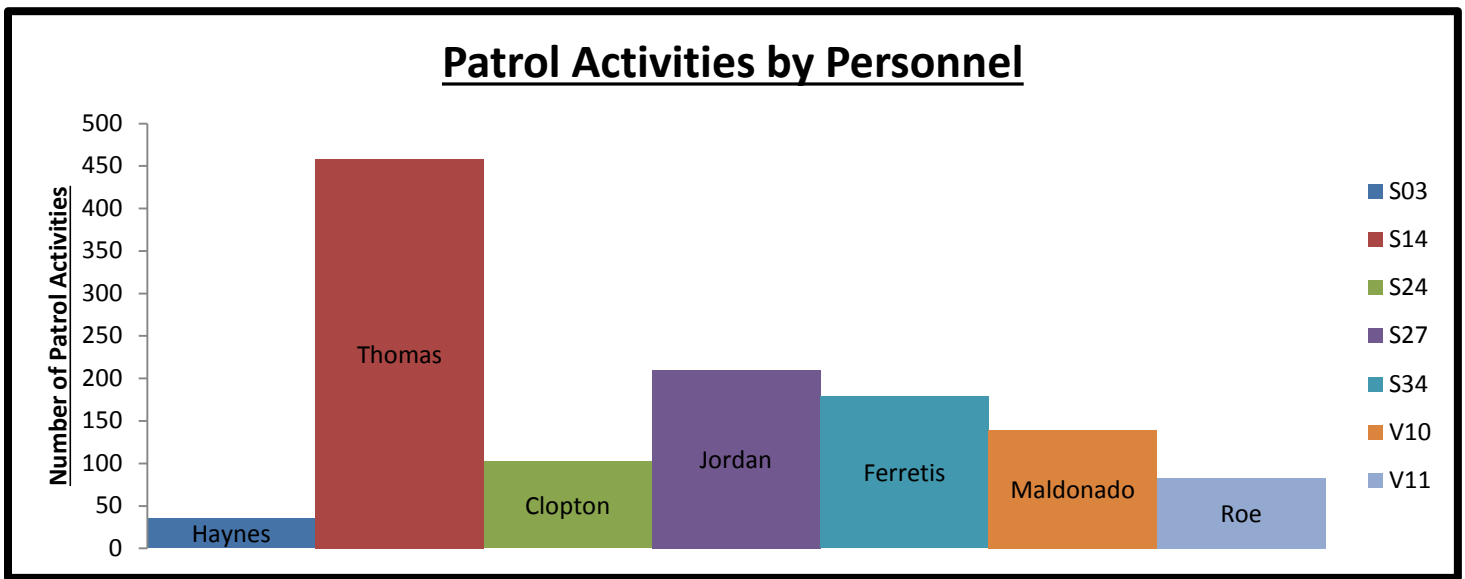

A2. Patrol Activity by Midtown Personnel:

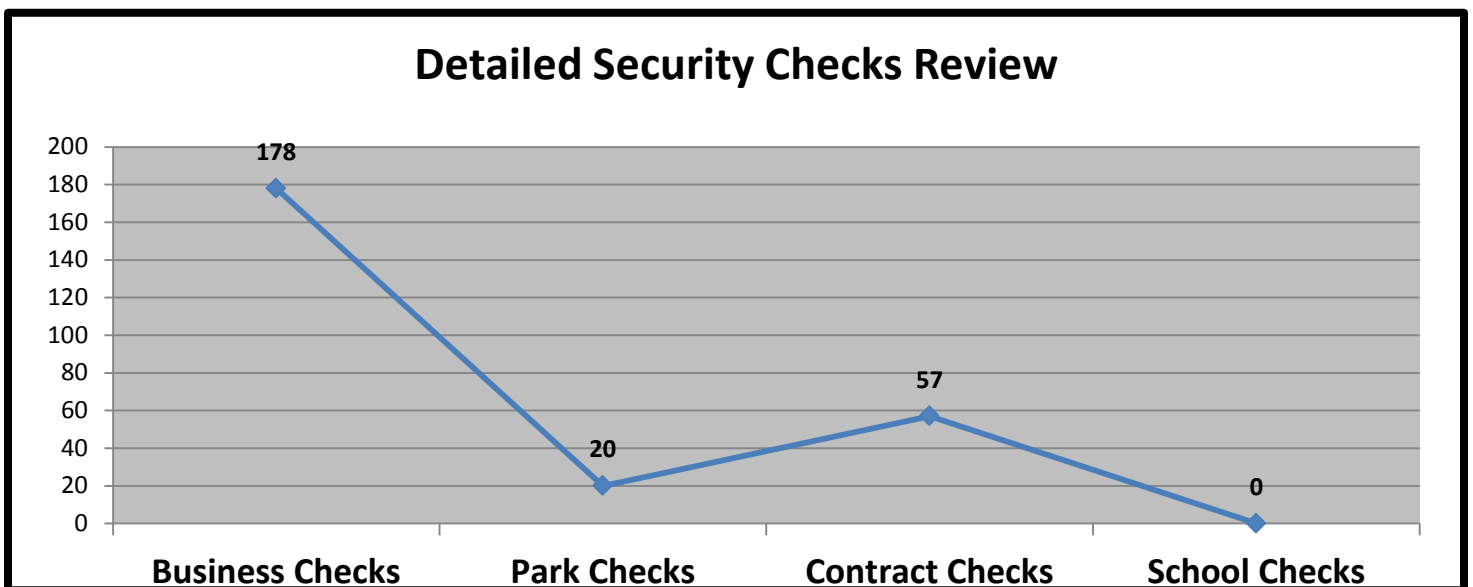

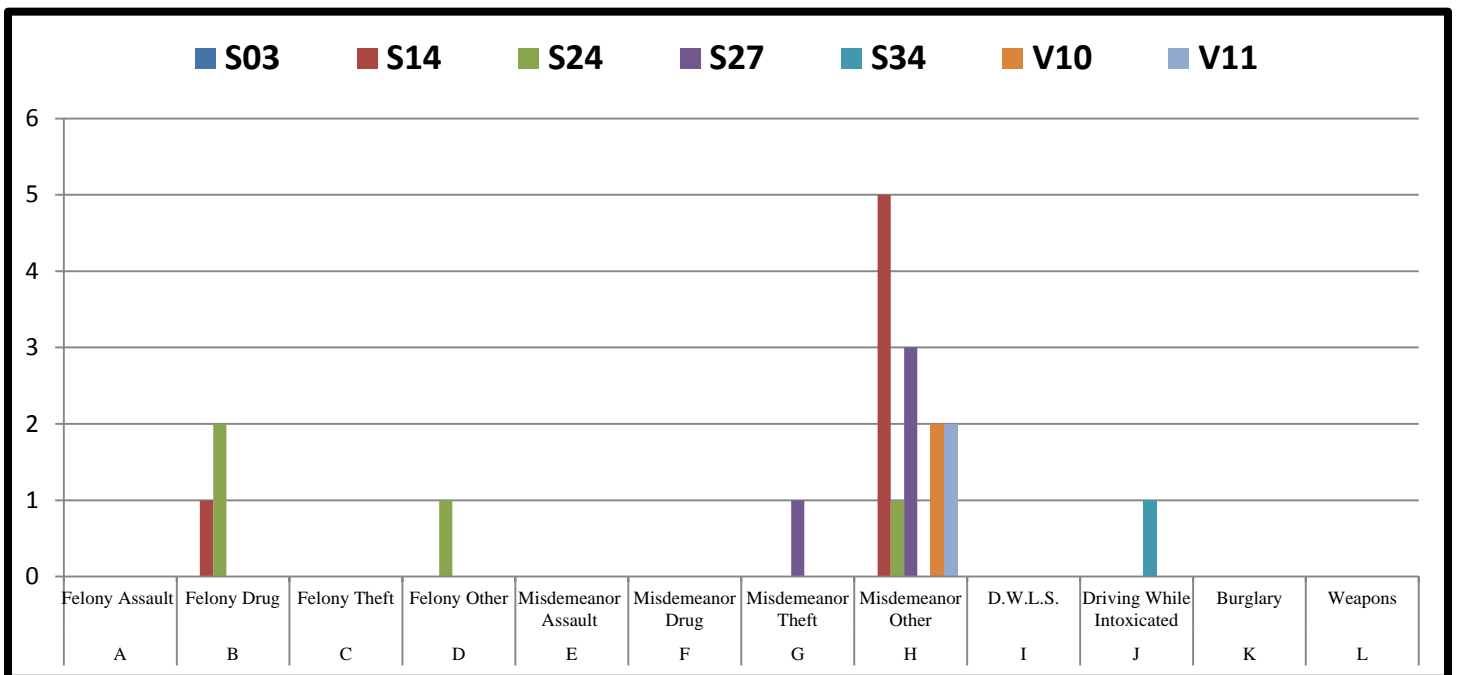

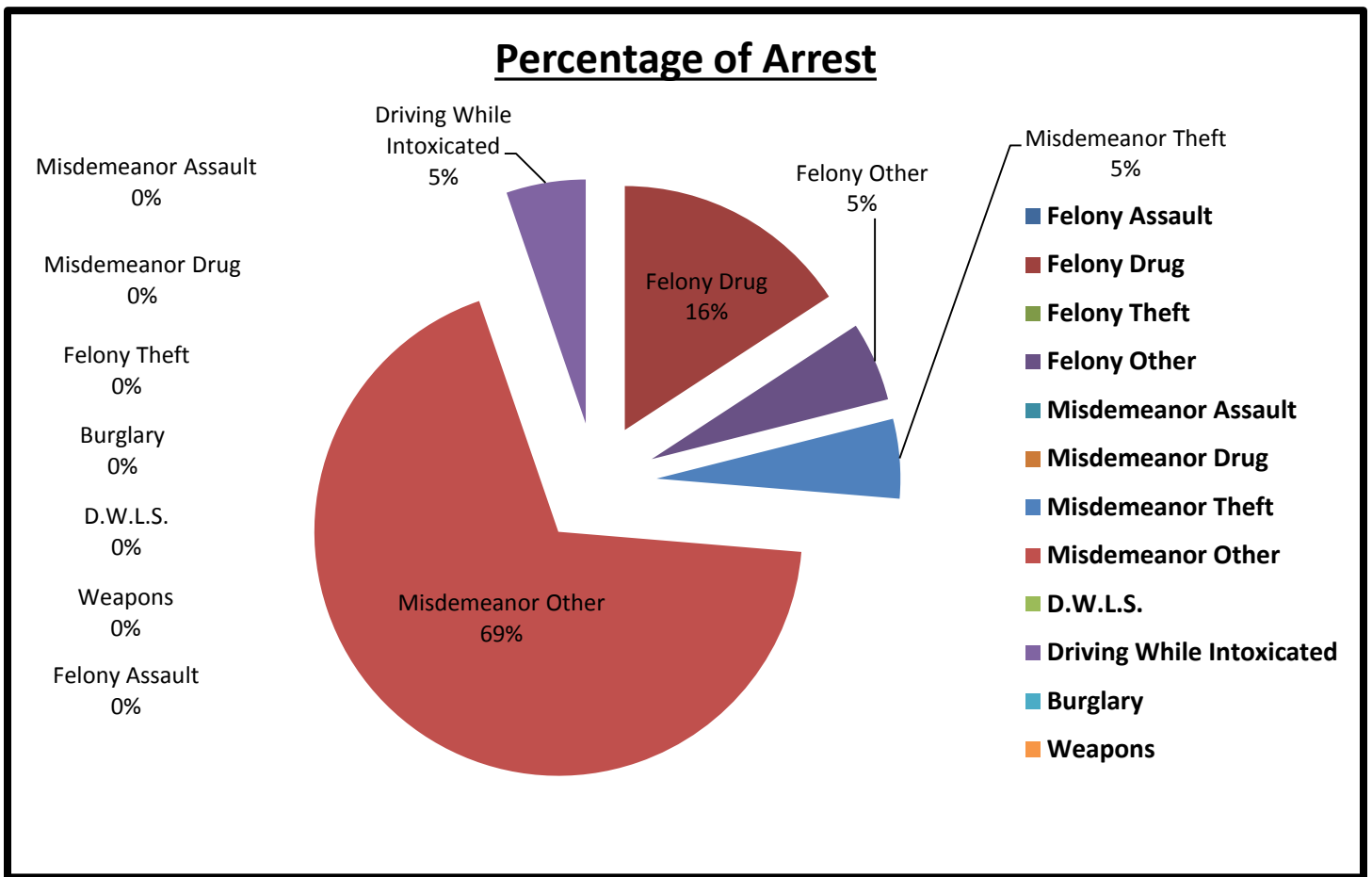
