	<p>ON AUG 2, 2012, AT APPROXIMATELY 3:19P.M., WHILE ON PATROL IN THE GREATER SOUTHEAST MANAGEMENT DISTRICT CONTRACT REPORTING DEPUTY C. JOLIVET JR., 7S22 WAS FLAGGED DOWN AT THE 4500 BLK. OF S. MACGREGOR WAY IN REFERENCE TO A CRIMINAL MISCHIEF.
