<p>ON MAY 3, 2012 AT APPROXIMATELY 3:42 P.M., WHILE ON PATROL IN THE GREATER SOUTHEAST MANAGEMENT DISTRICT CONTRACT REPORTING DEPUTY C. JOLIVET JR., 7S22 RECEIVED A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A THEFT LOCATED AT 3520 OST AT THE TEXACO.</p> <p>UPON ARRIVAL TO THE LOCATION THE REPORTING DEPUTY SPOKE TO THE REPORTEE INSIDE THE BUSINESS.
