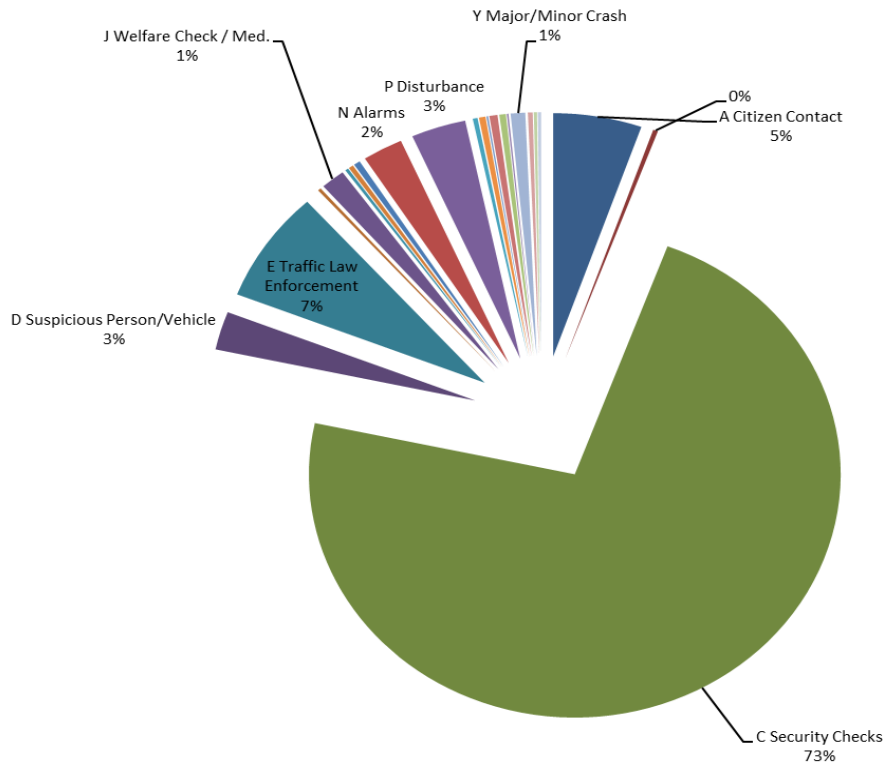
A total of **960** man-hours was scheduled; however, **584** man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. The other **376** hours were exhausted on vacation time, compensatory time, and sick leave. **2,869** total miles were driven, and the shift responded to **1,015** total service calls. The shift issued **56** traffic citations and **18** warnings, made **7** arrests, and handled **76** enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is **3.2**.

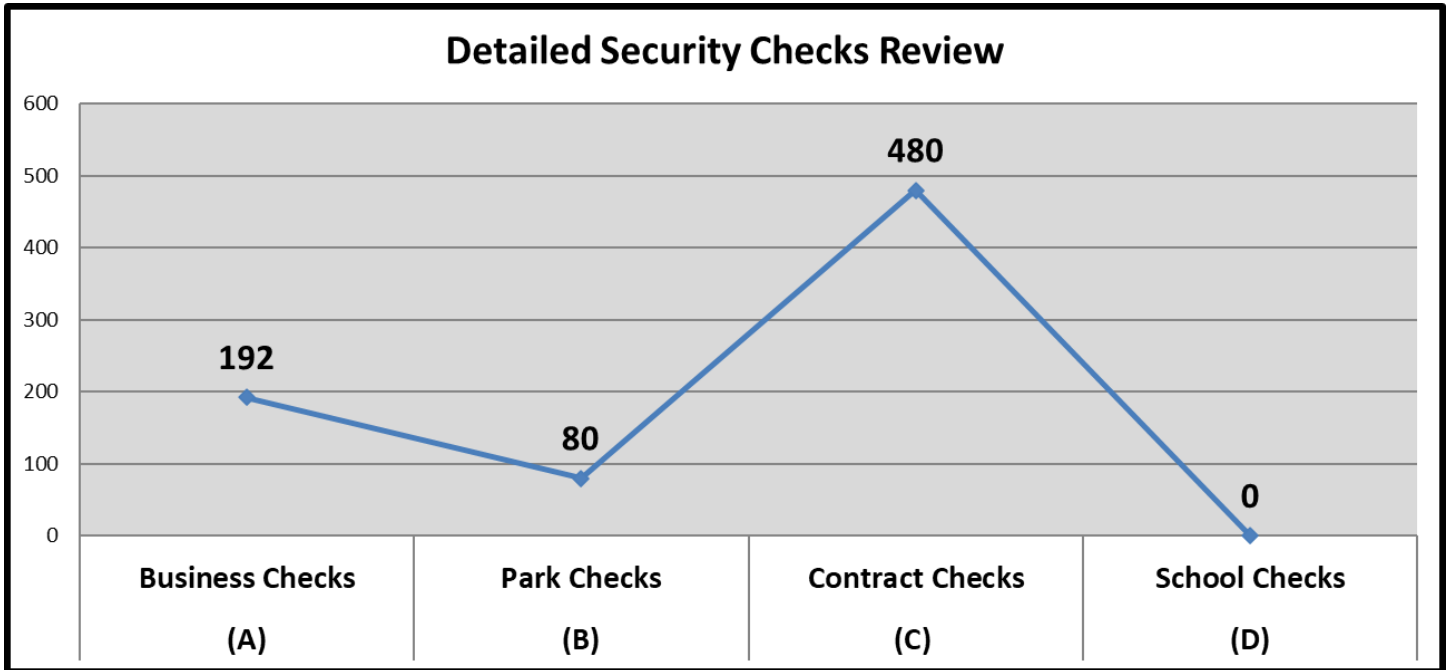
Patrol Activity Percentages & Trends

Percentage of Patrol Activity

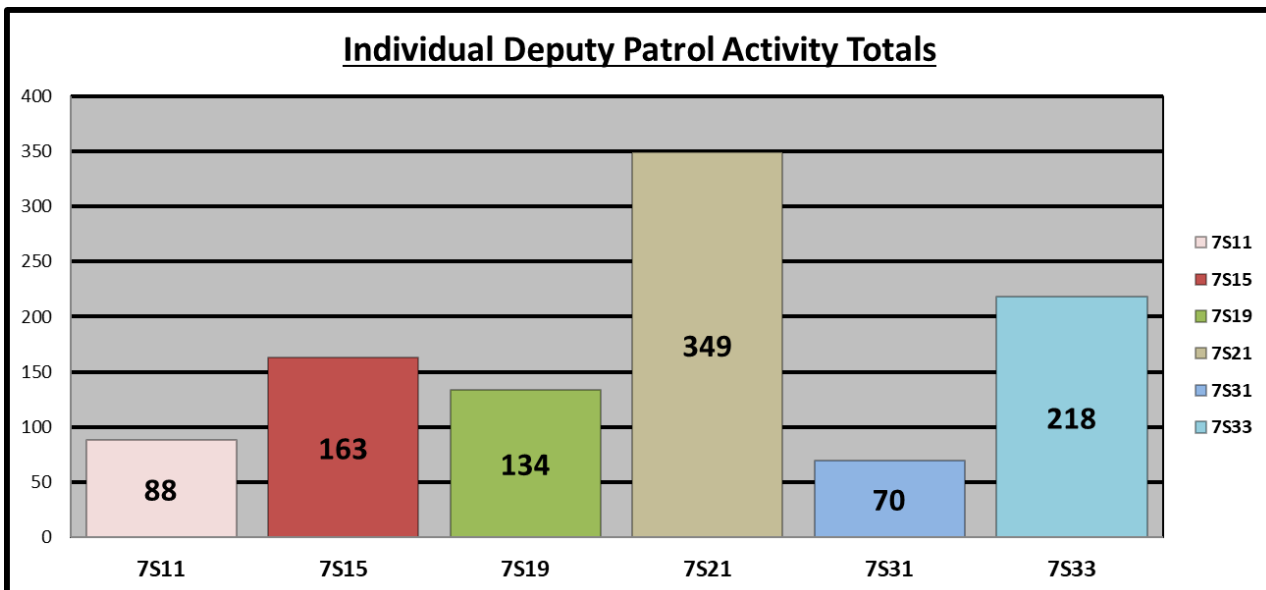

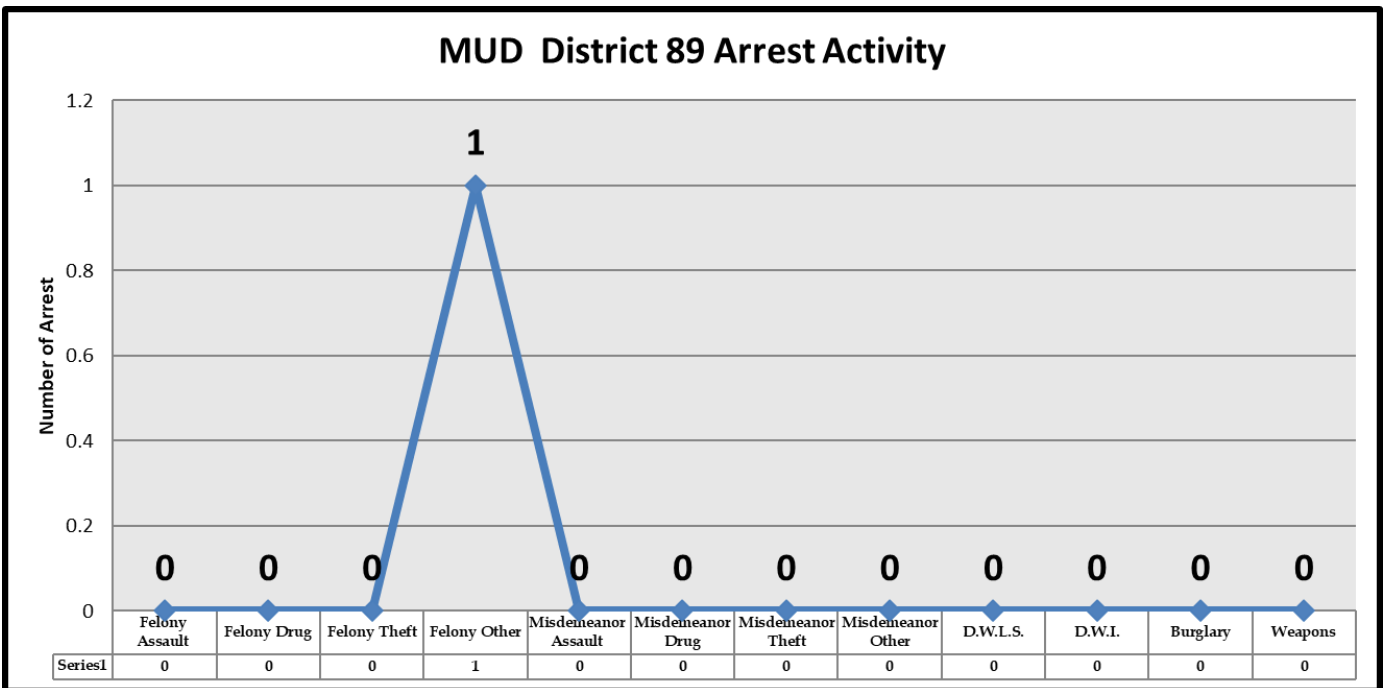

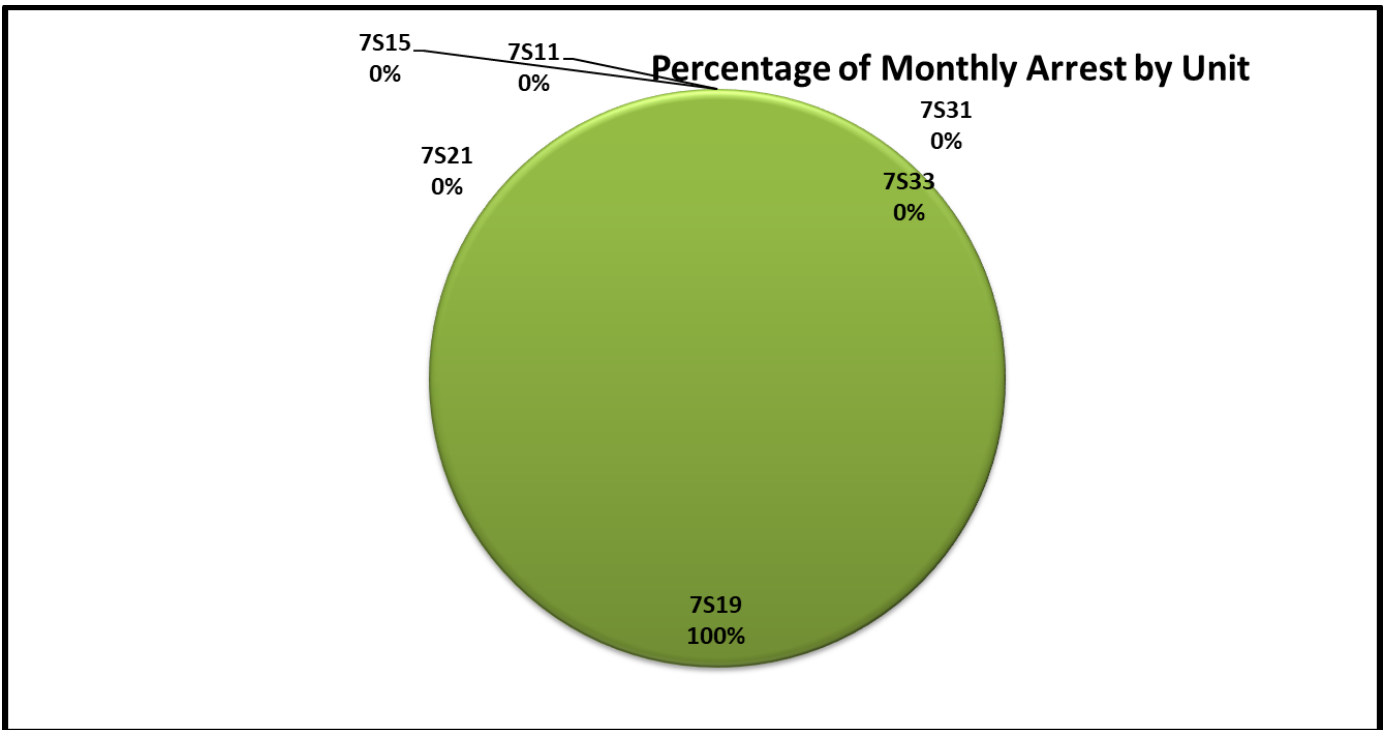

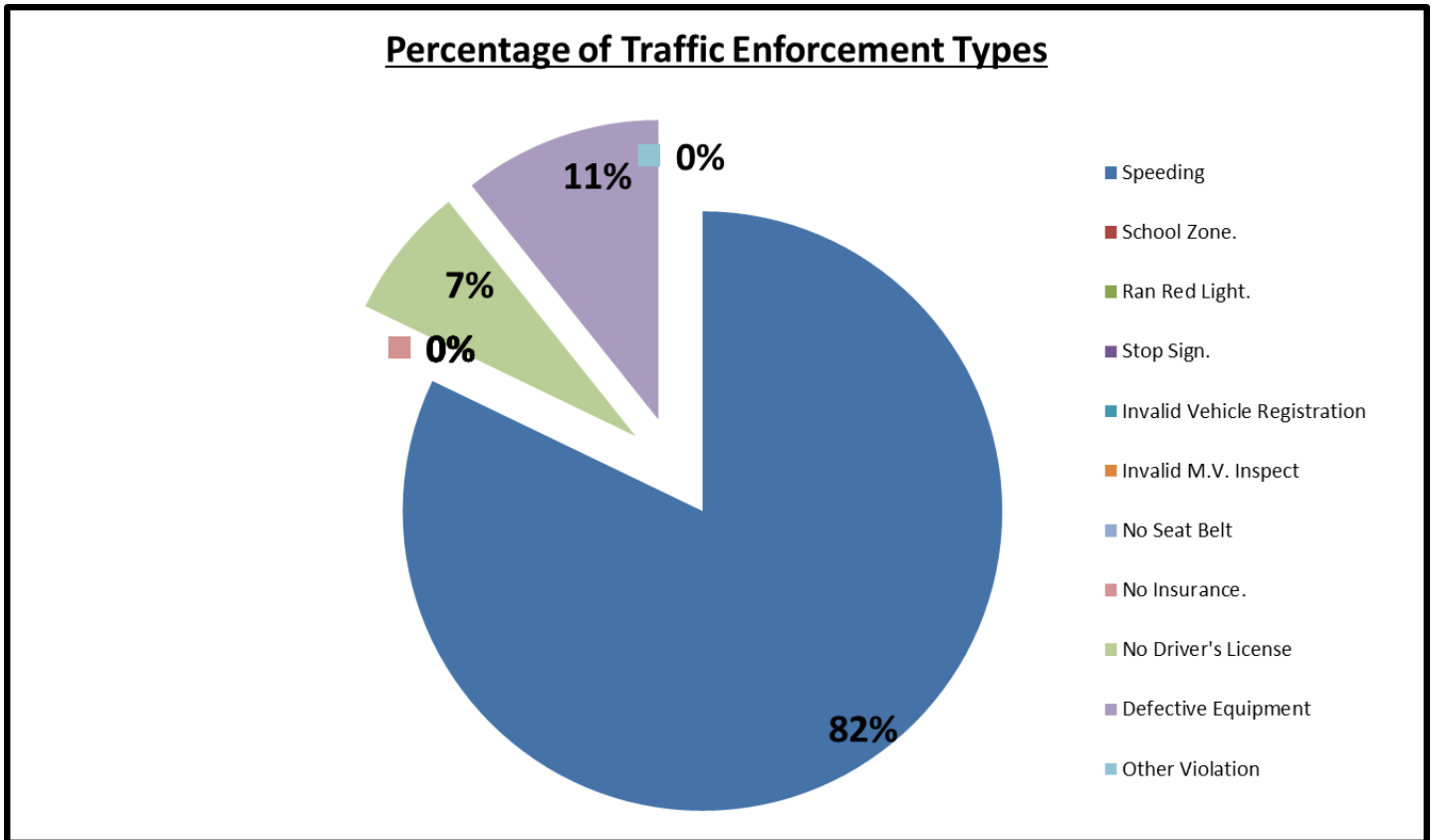
