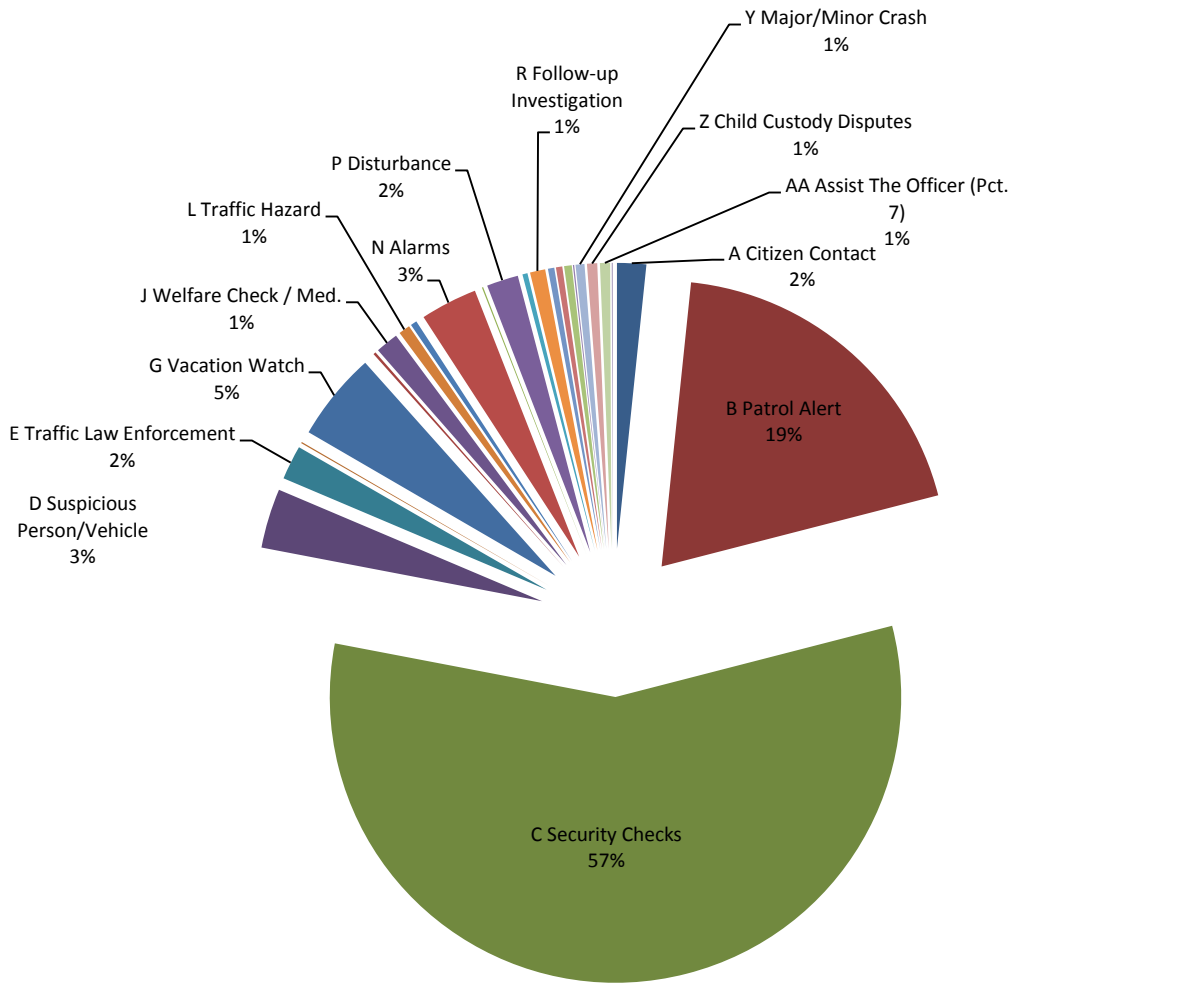

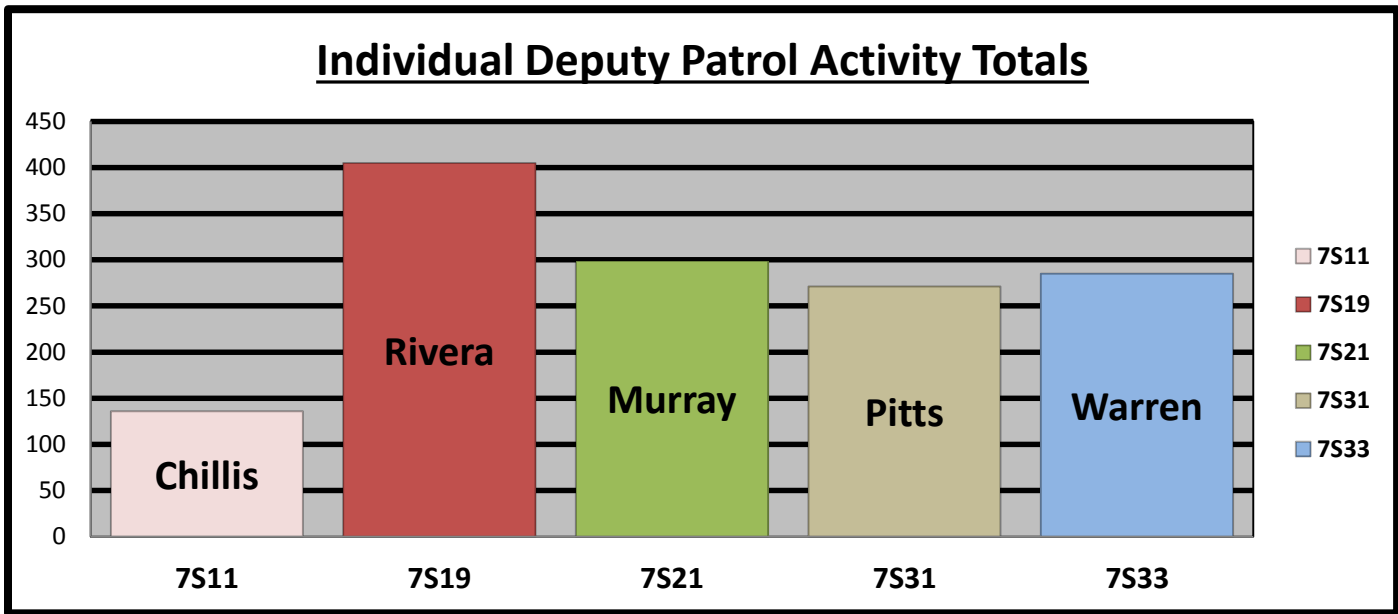

B. Patrol Activity by MUD District 89 Personnel:

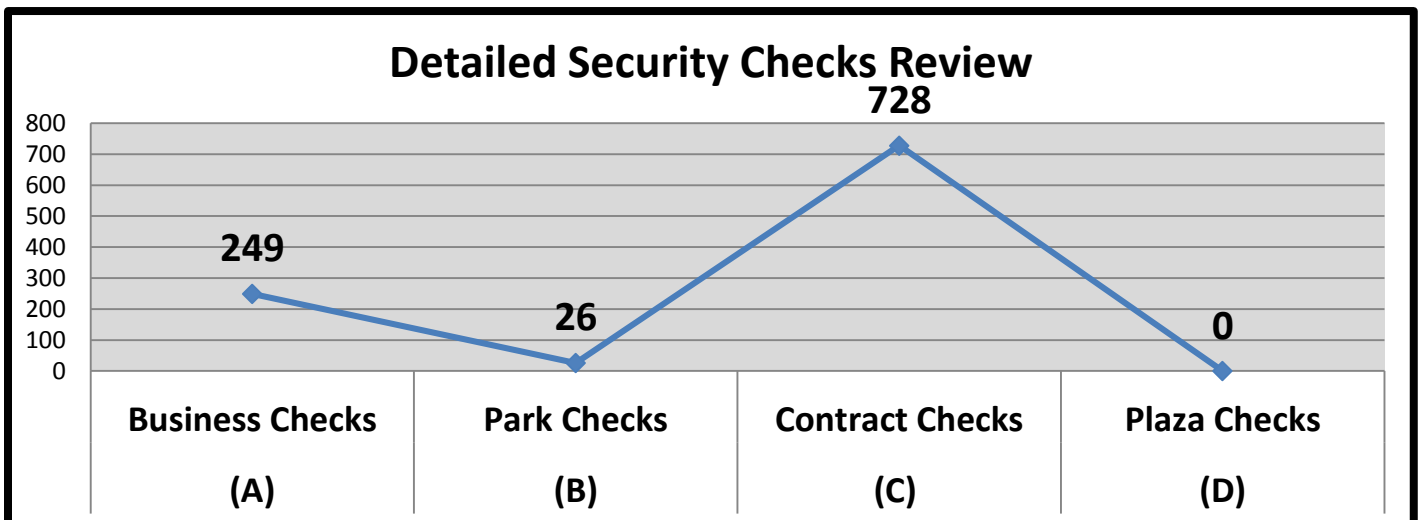

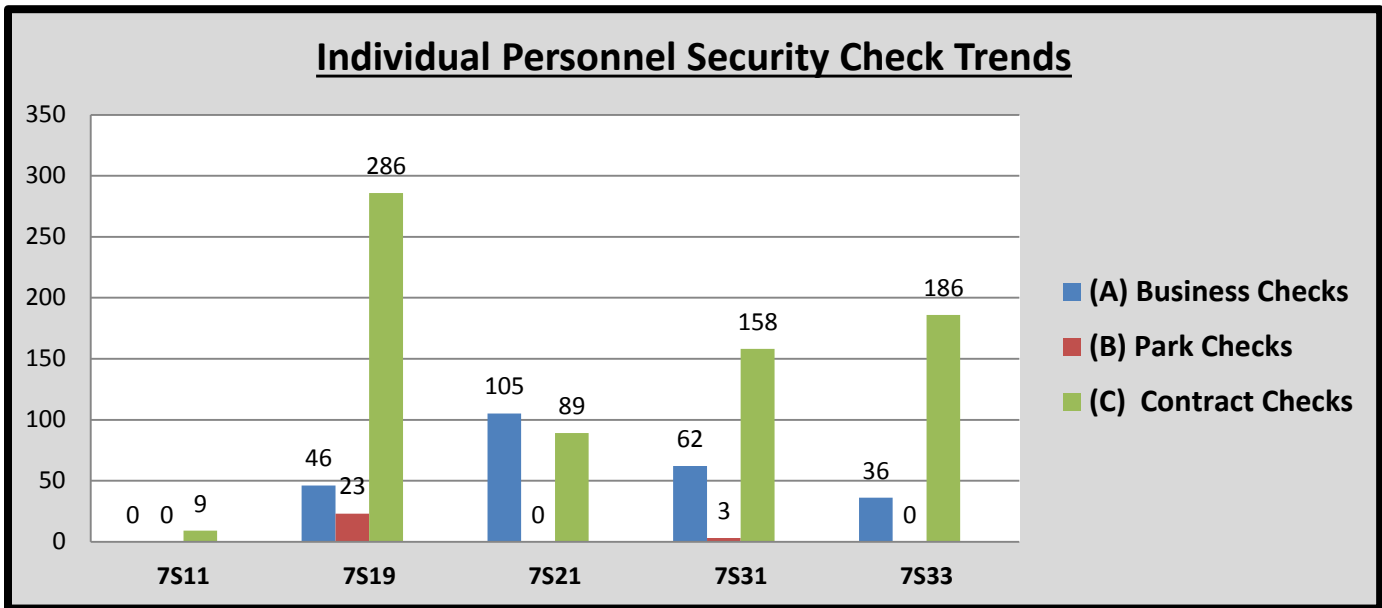

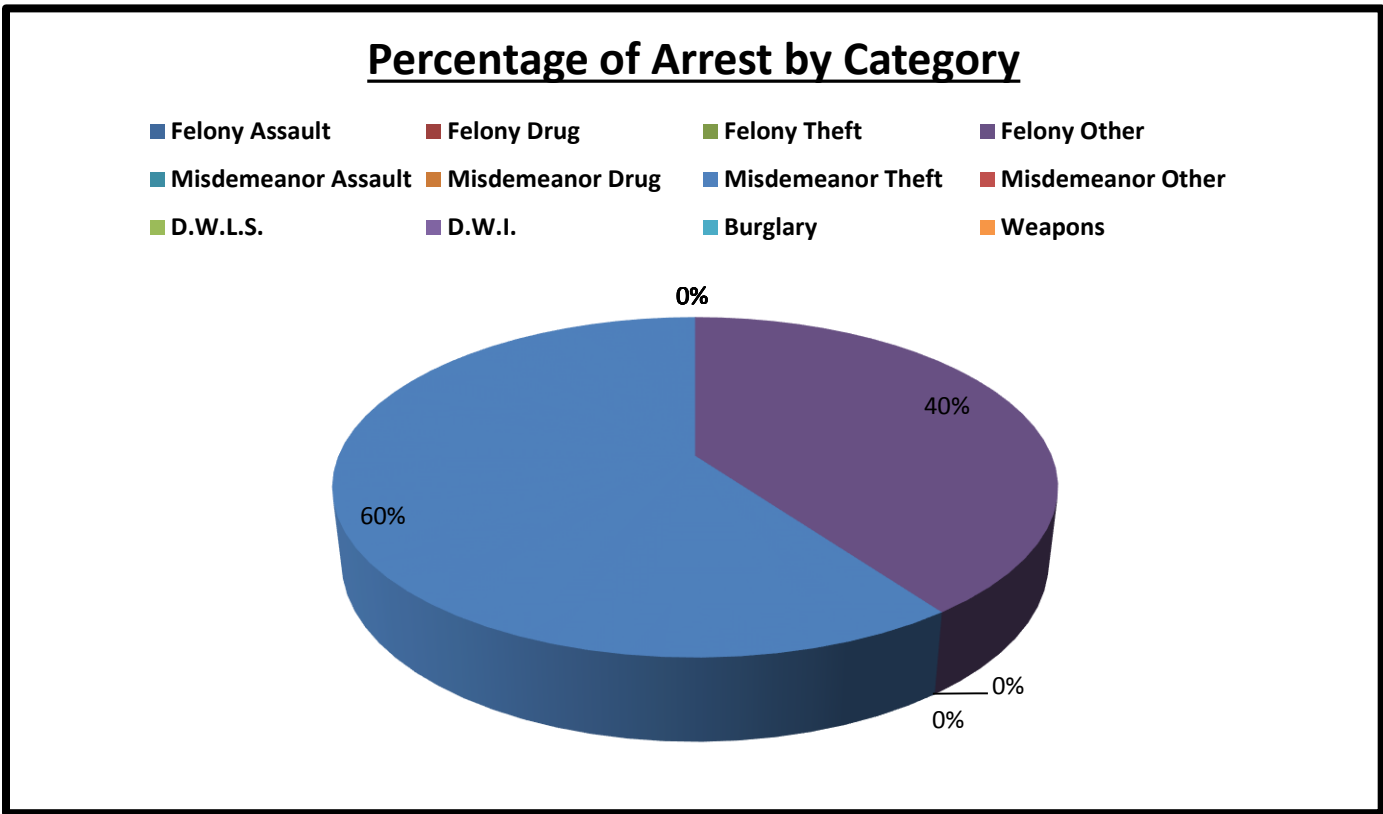

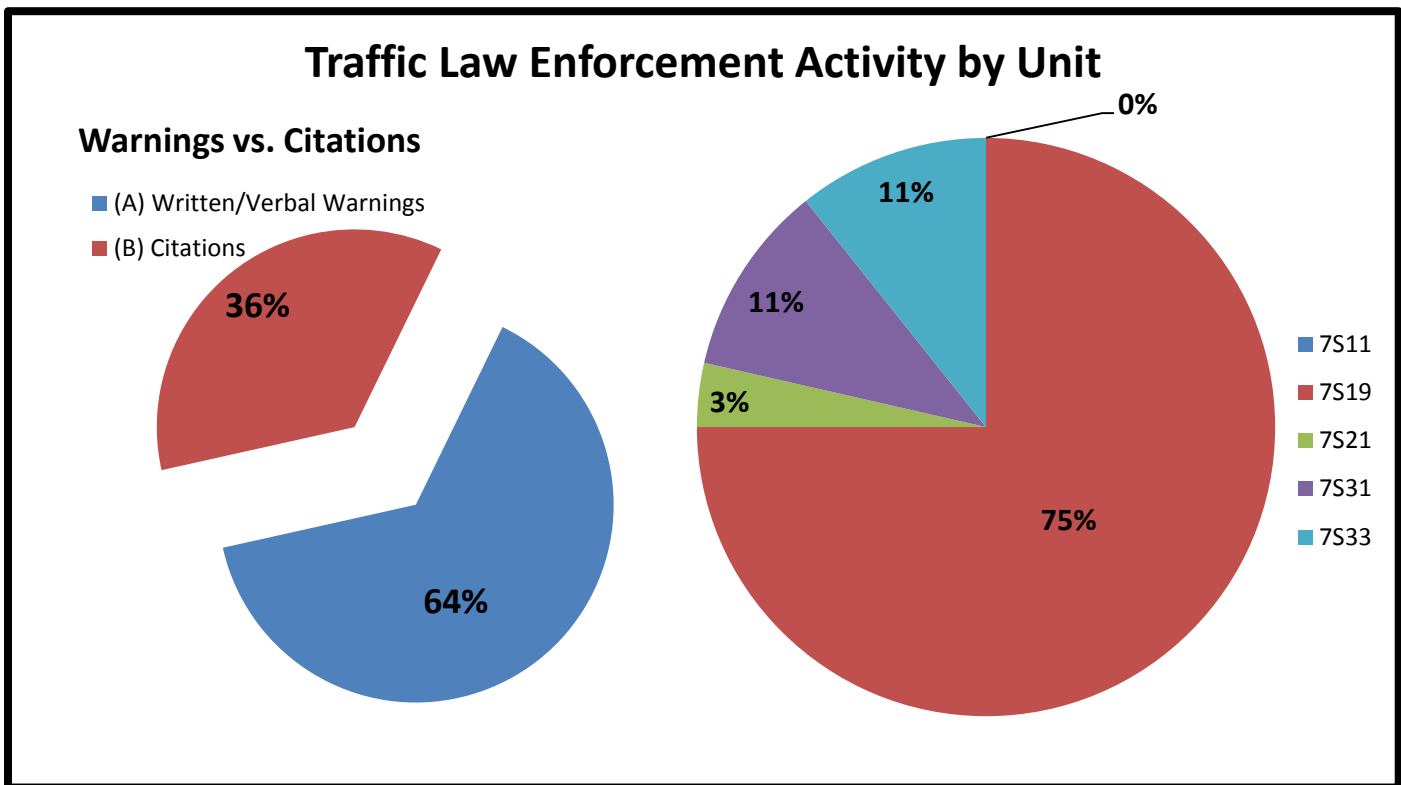

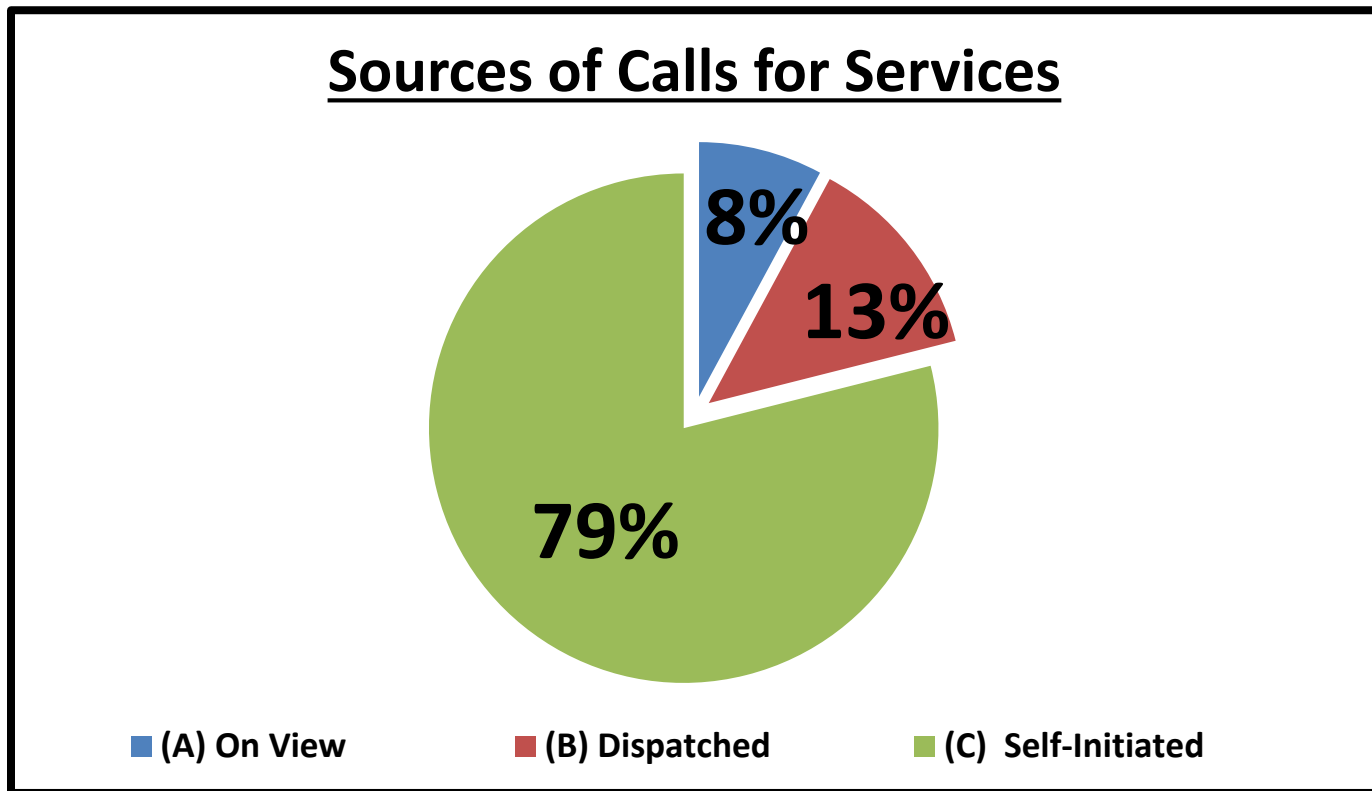
S. Sources of Calls for Service Percentages:
