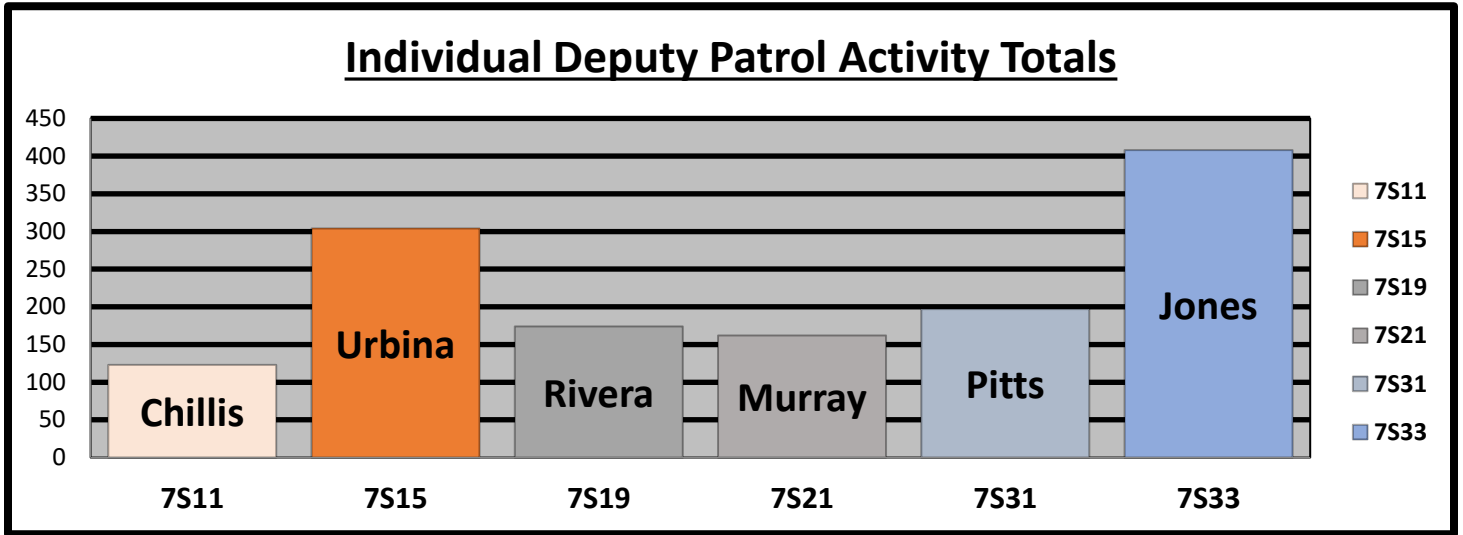

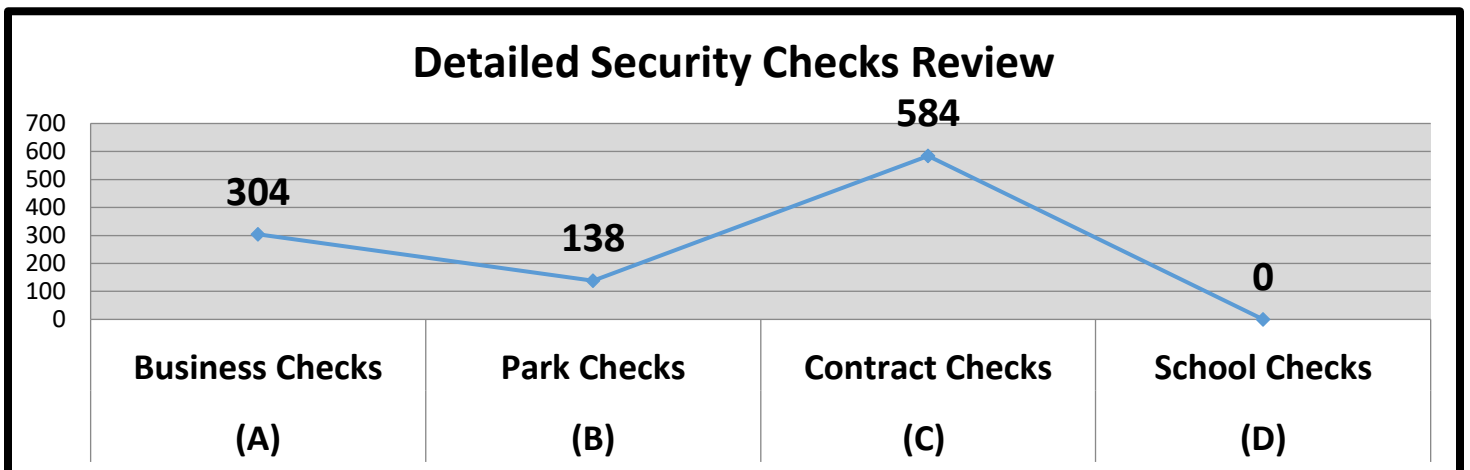

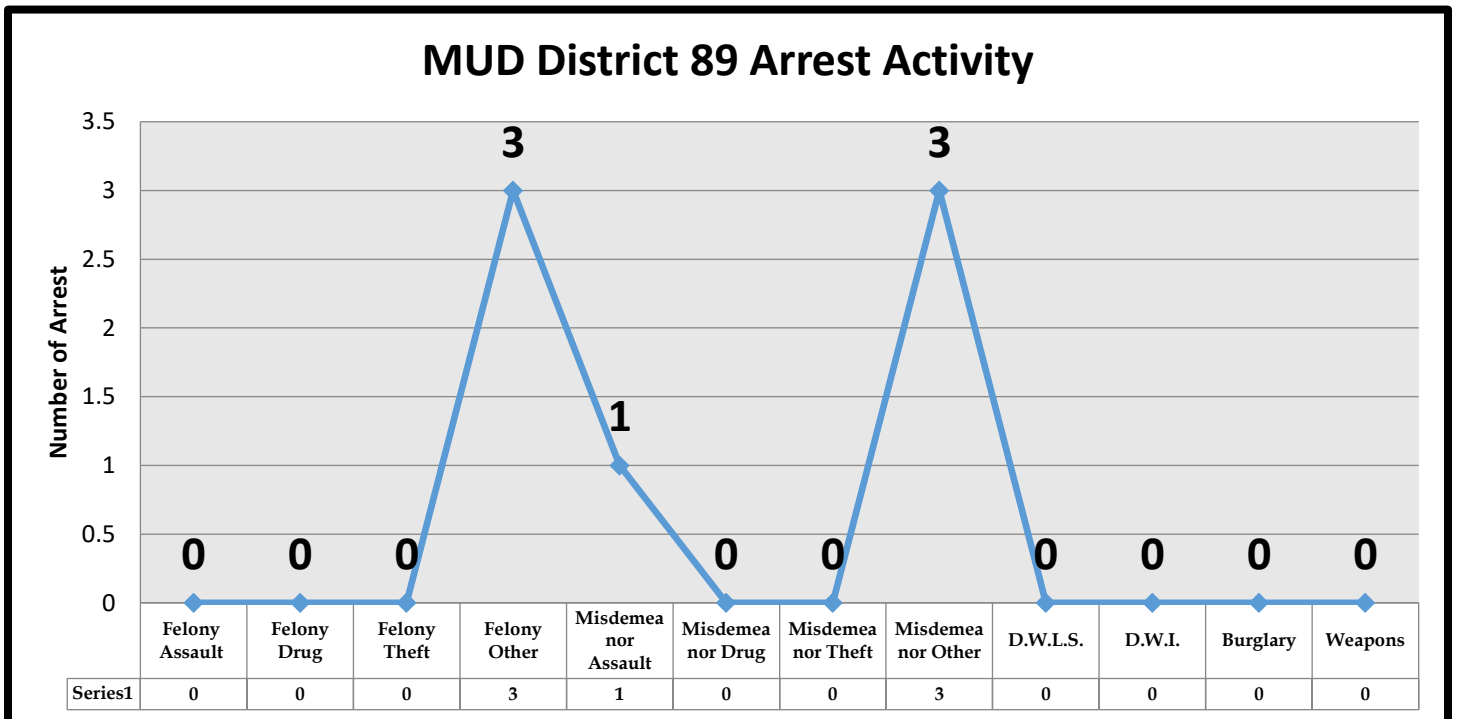

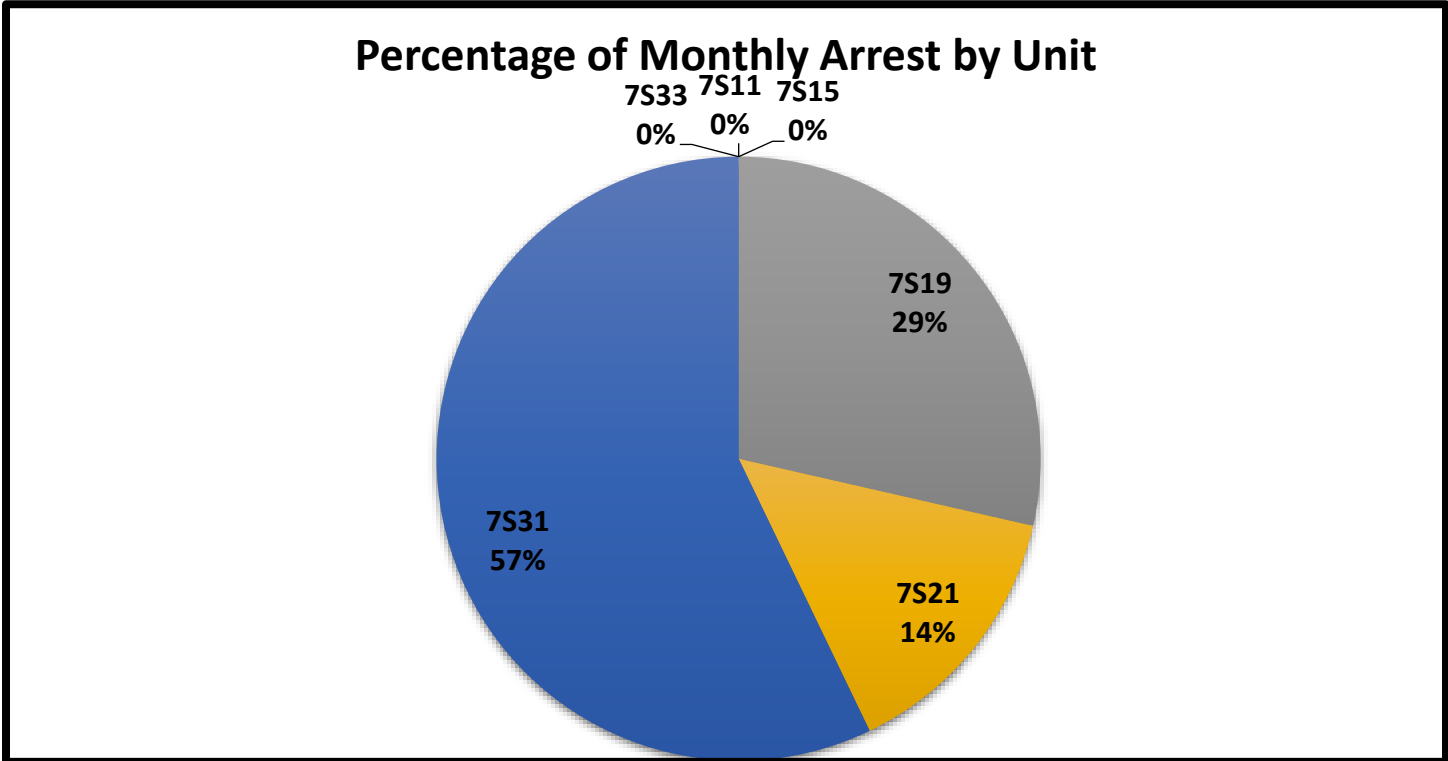

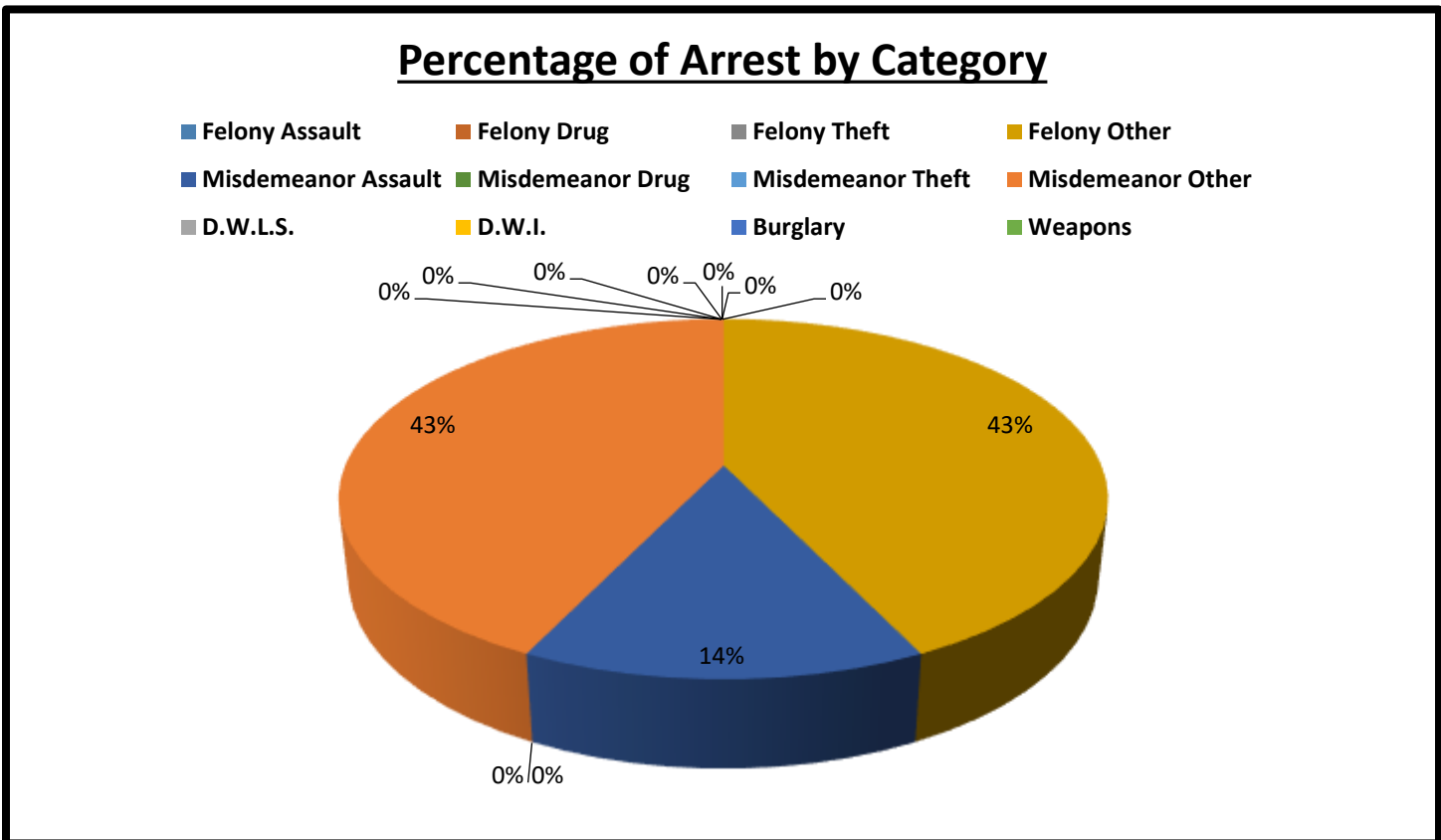

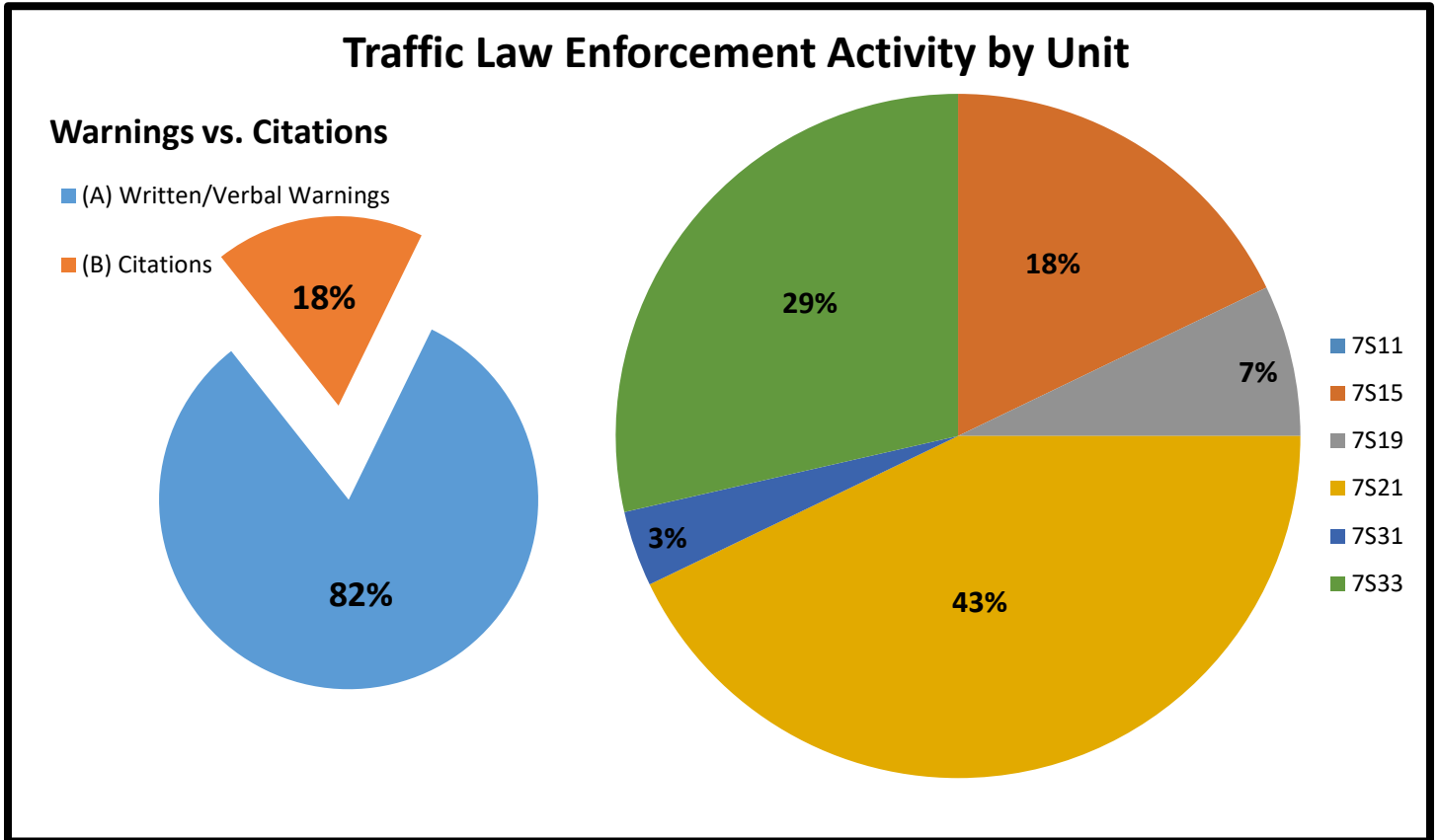

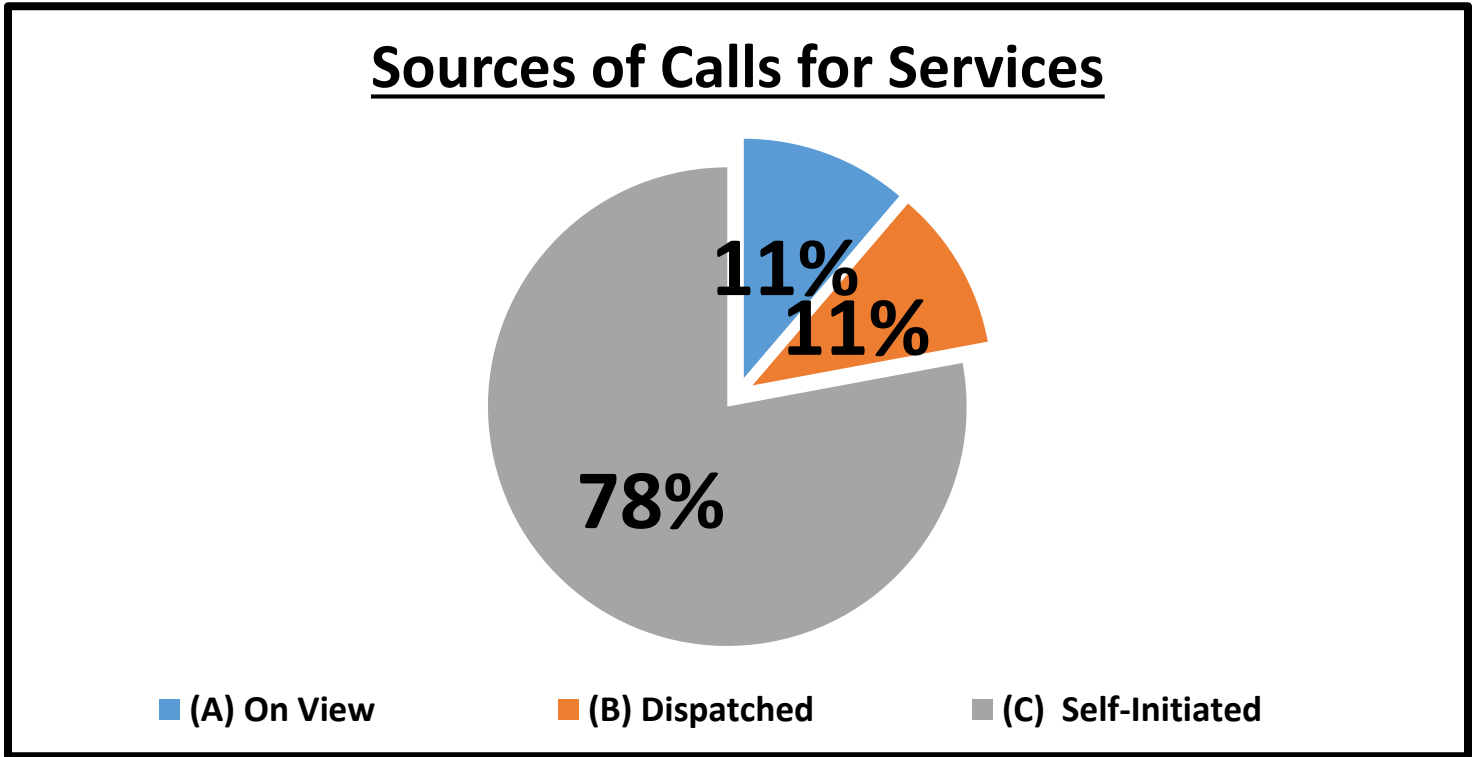
**S. Traffic Law Enforcement Activity by Unit Percentages:**
