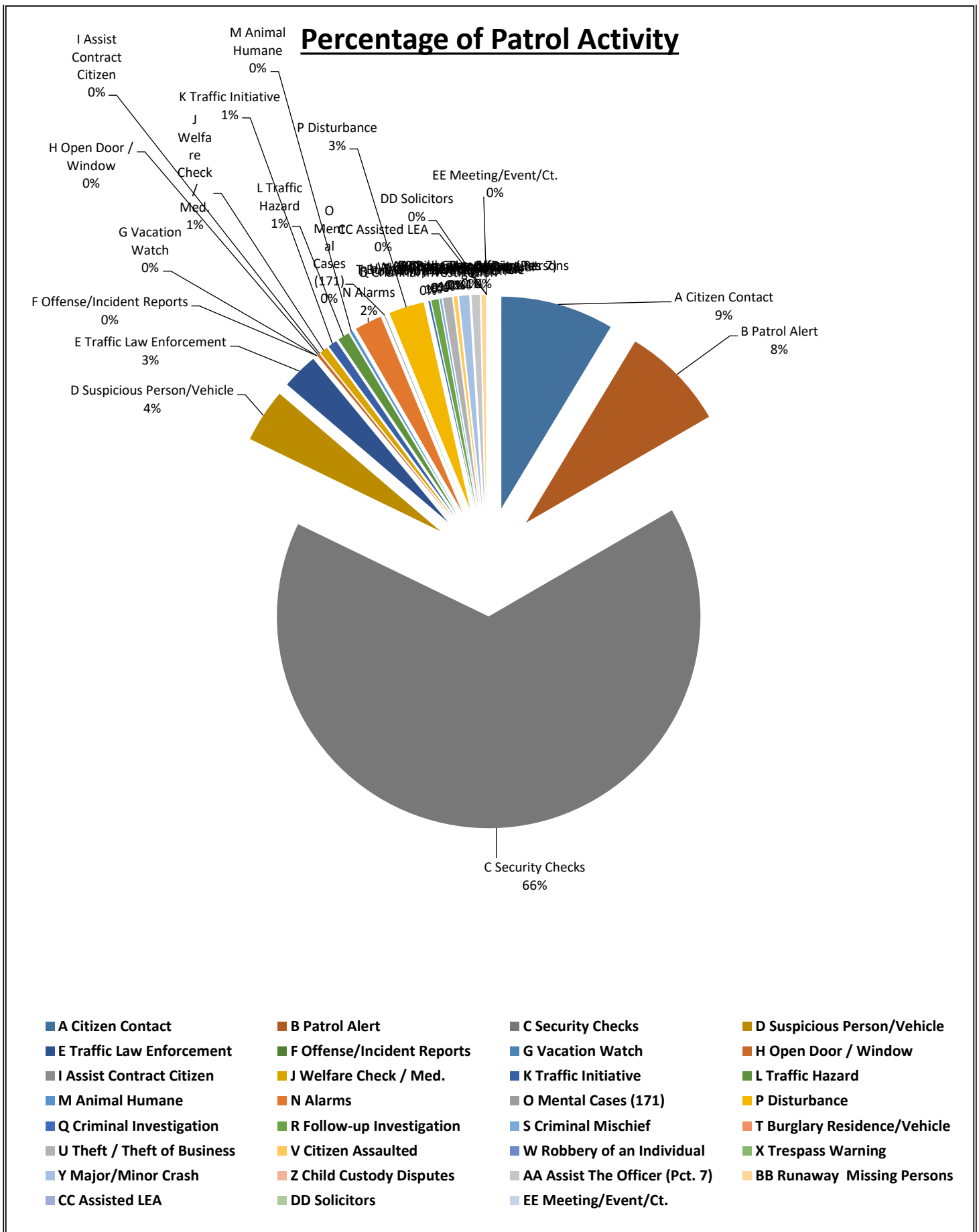

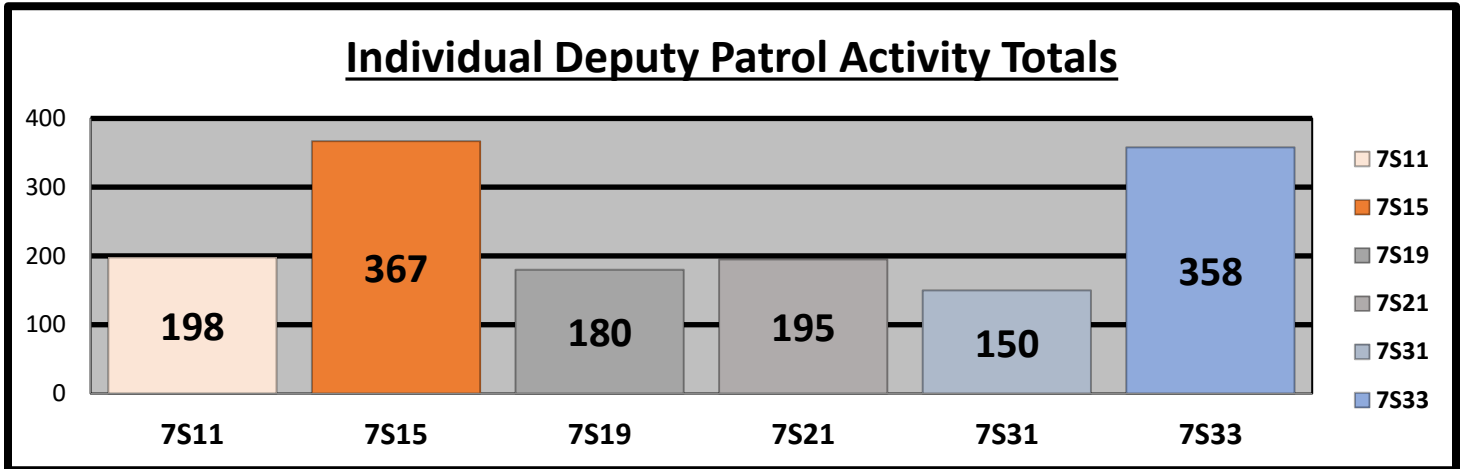

B. Patrol Activity by MUD District 89 Personnel:

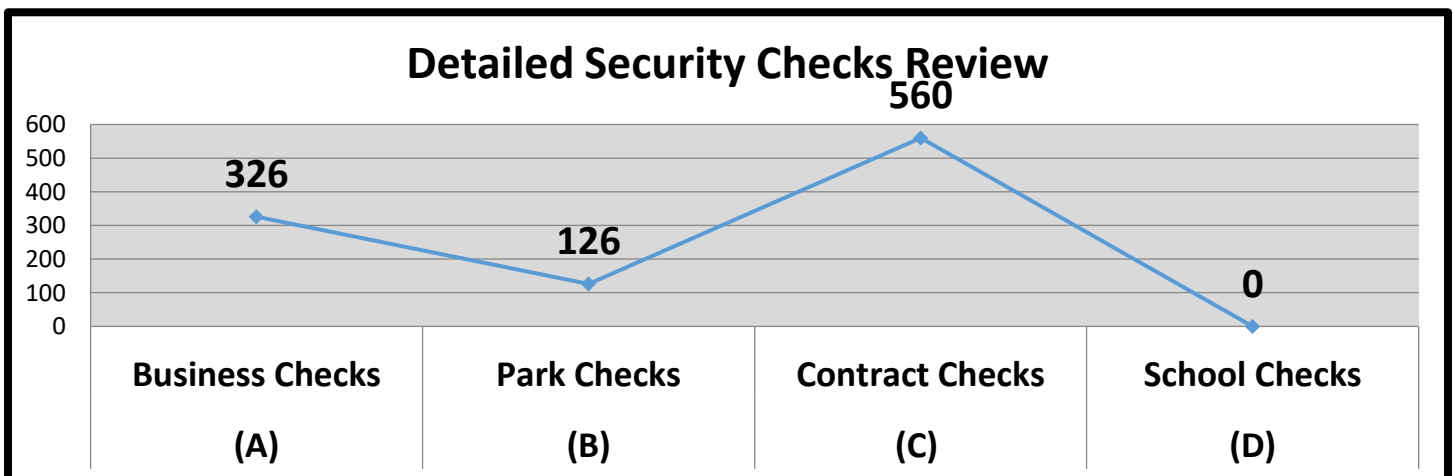

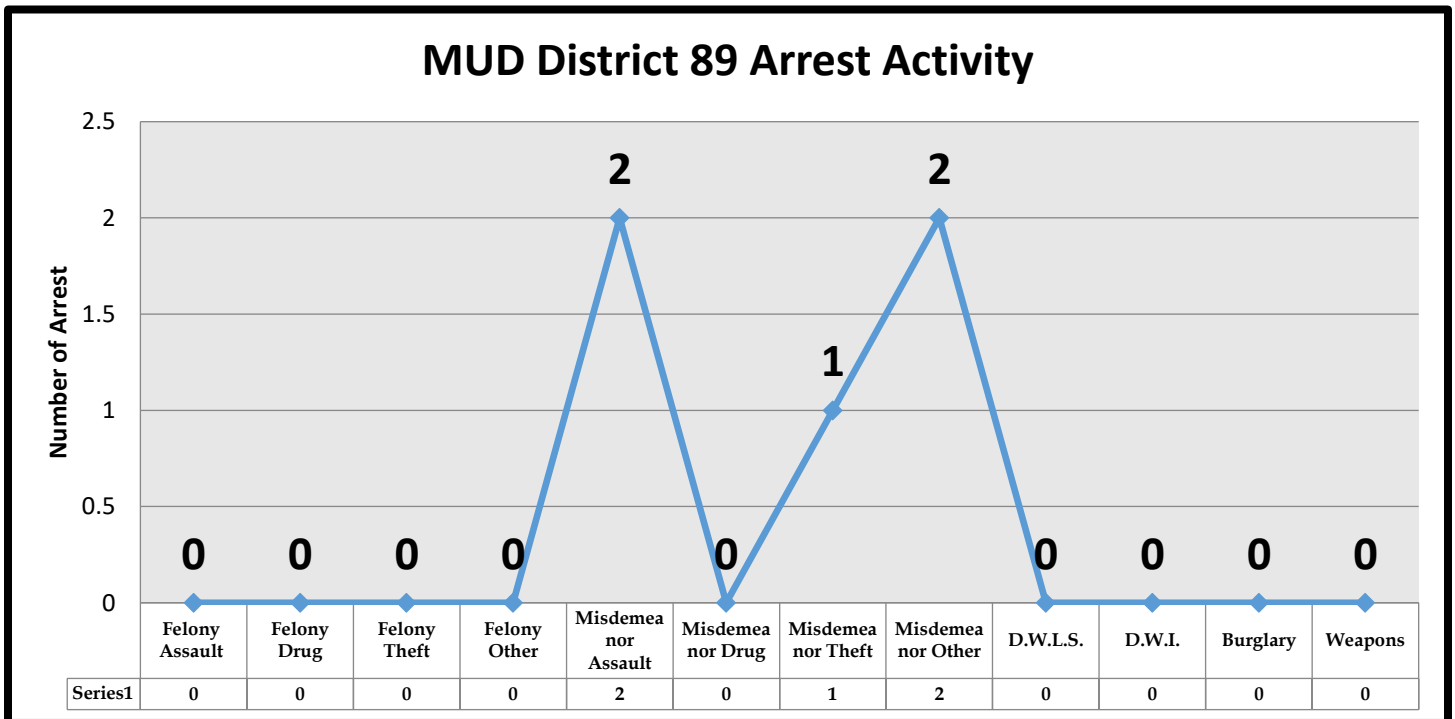

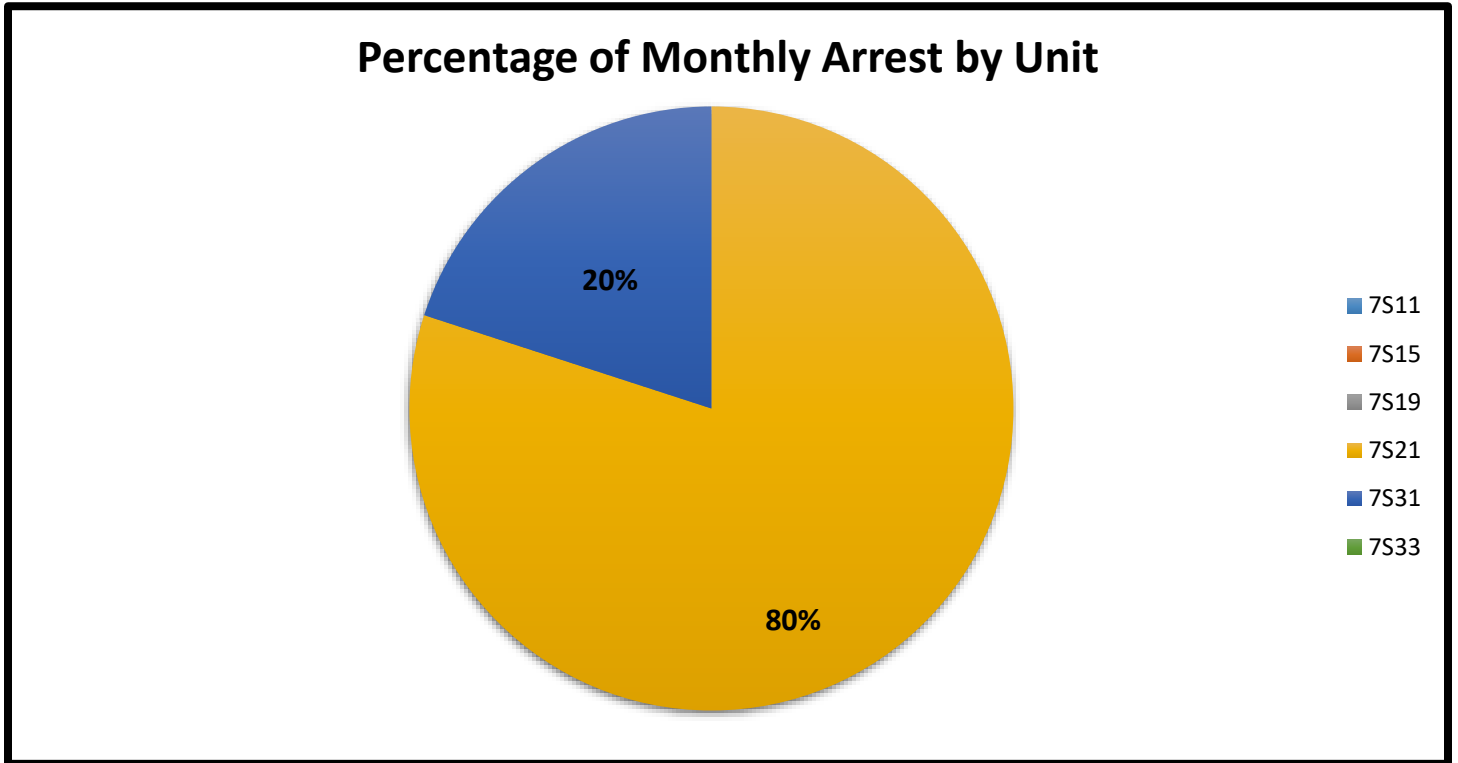

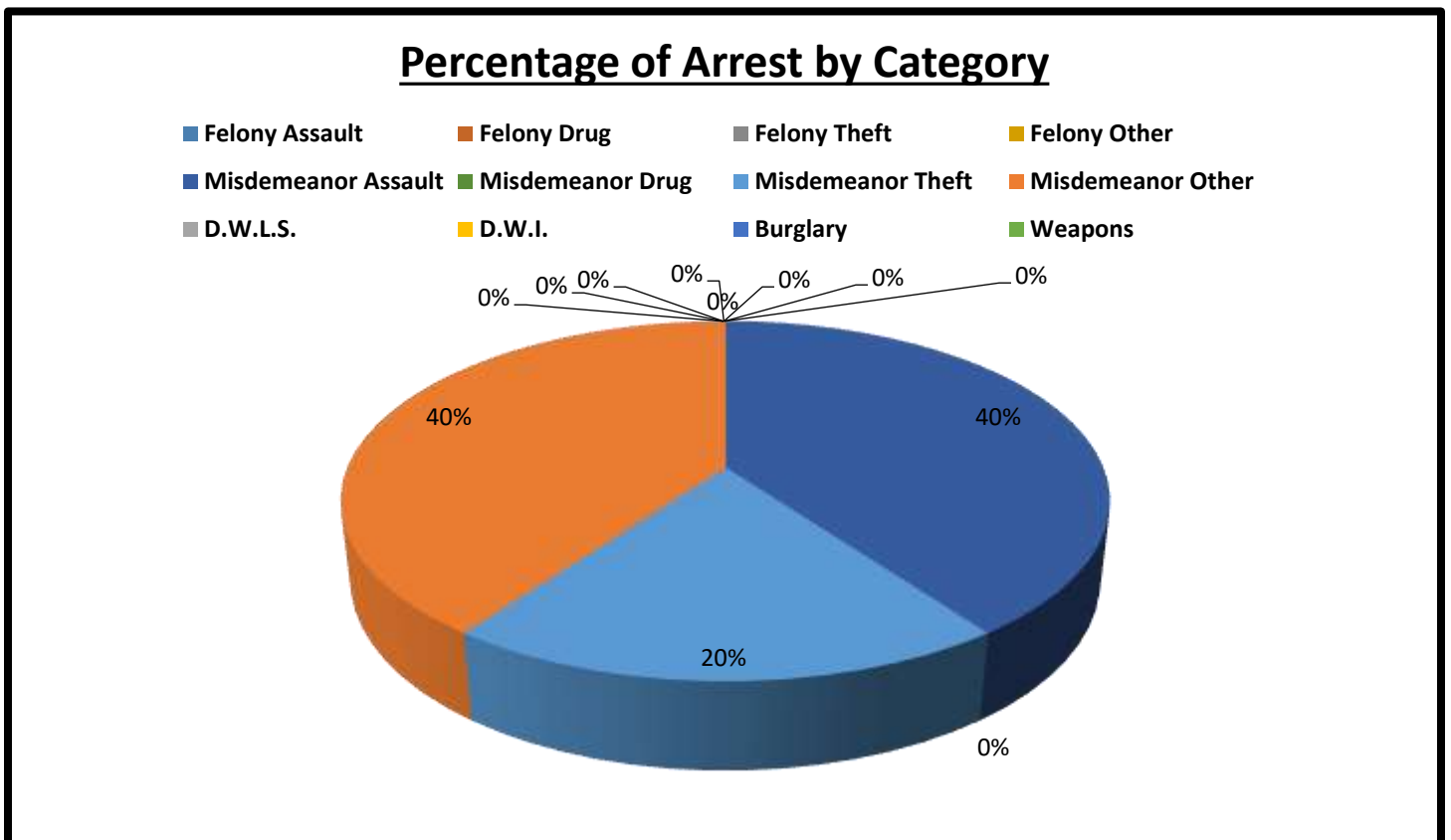
K. Types of Criminal Arrests Monthly Total:

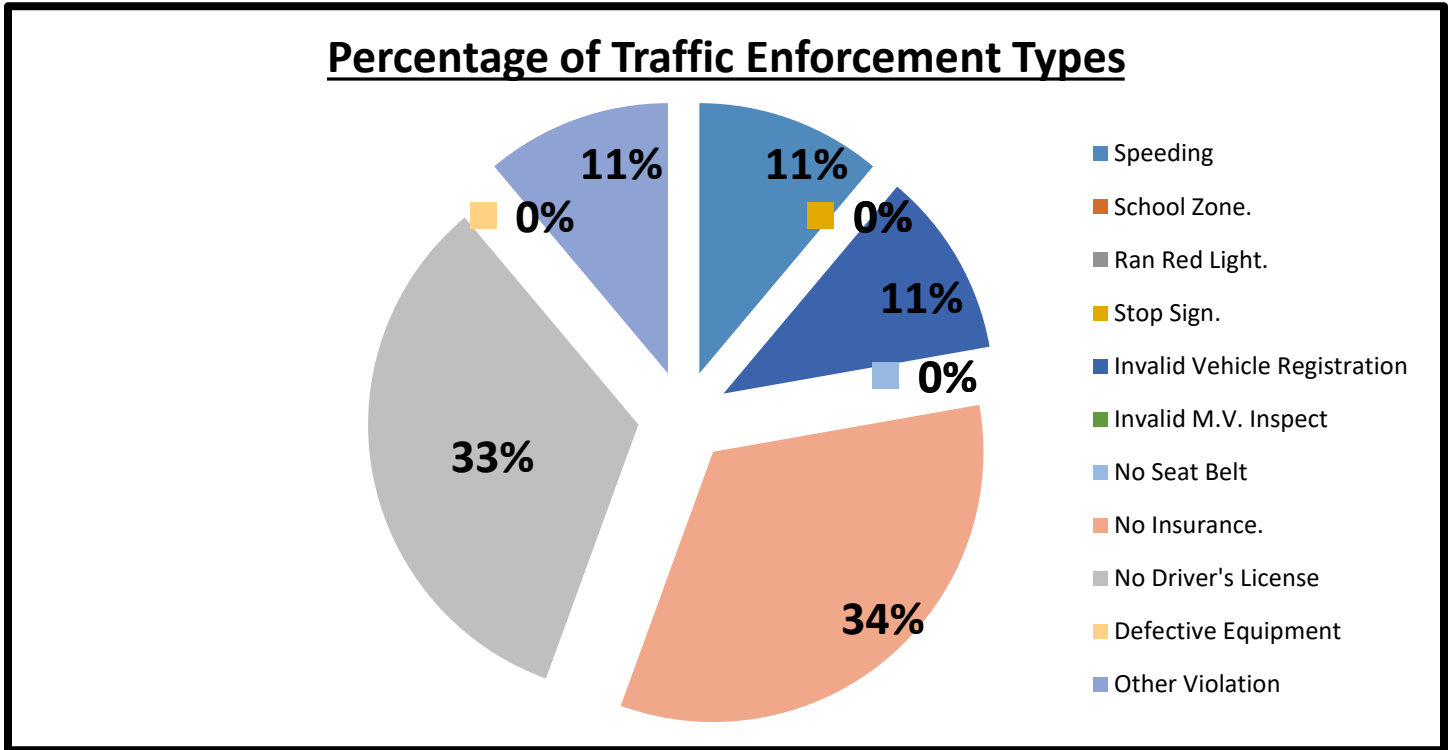

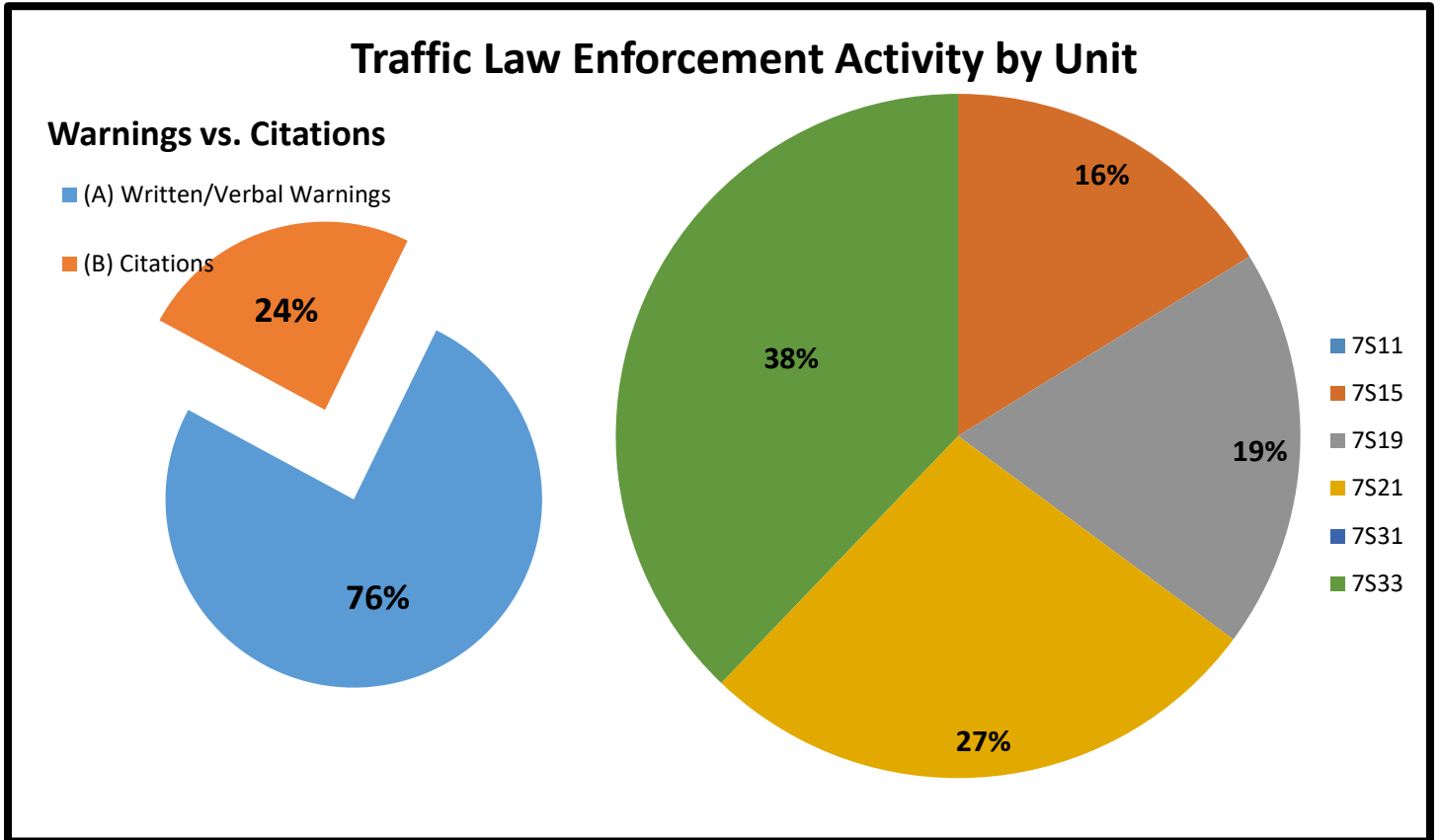

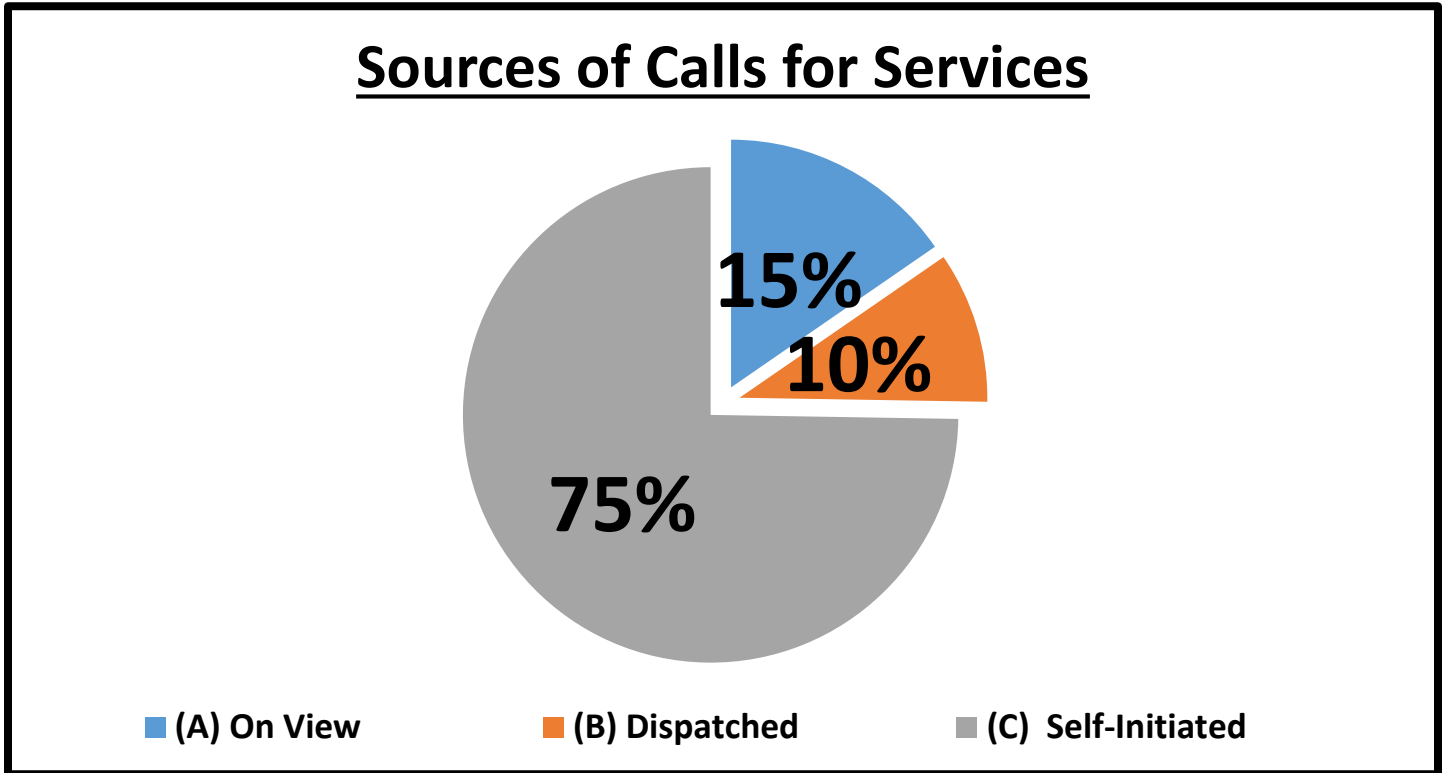
