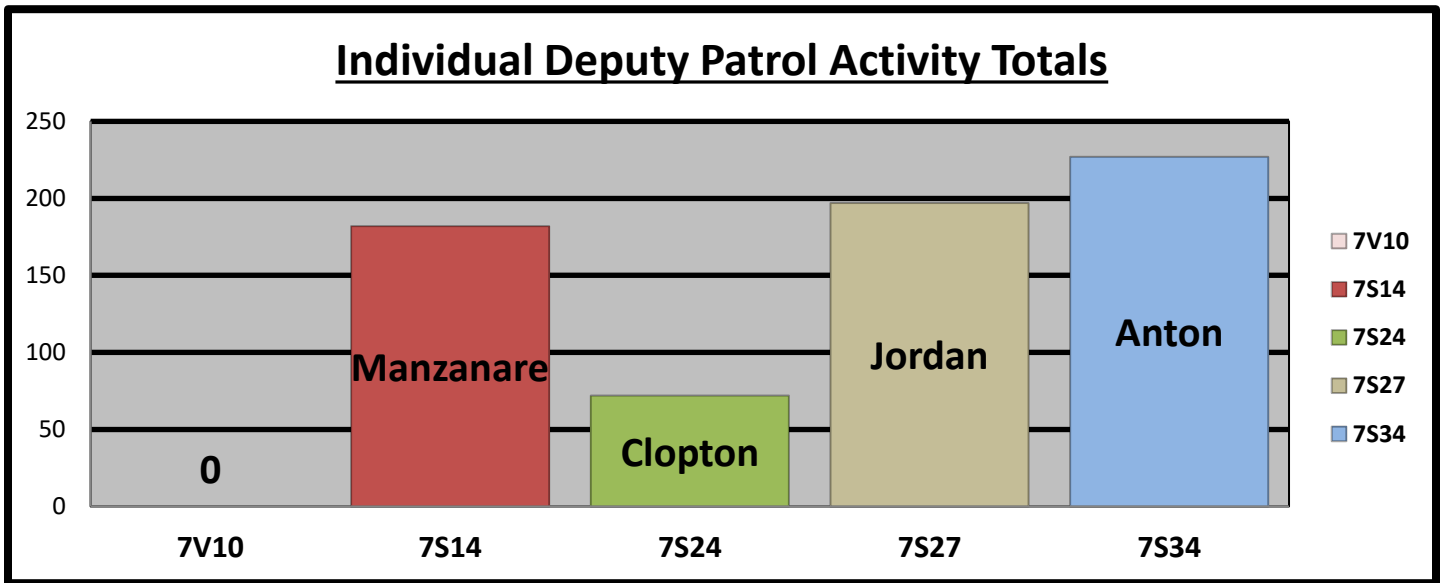

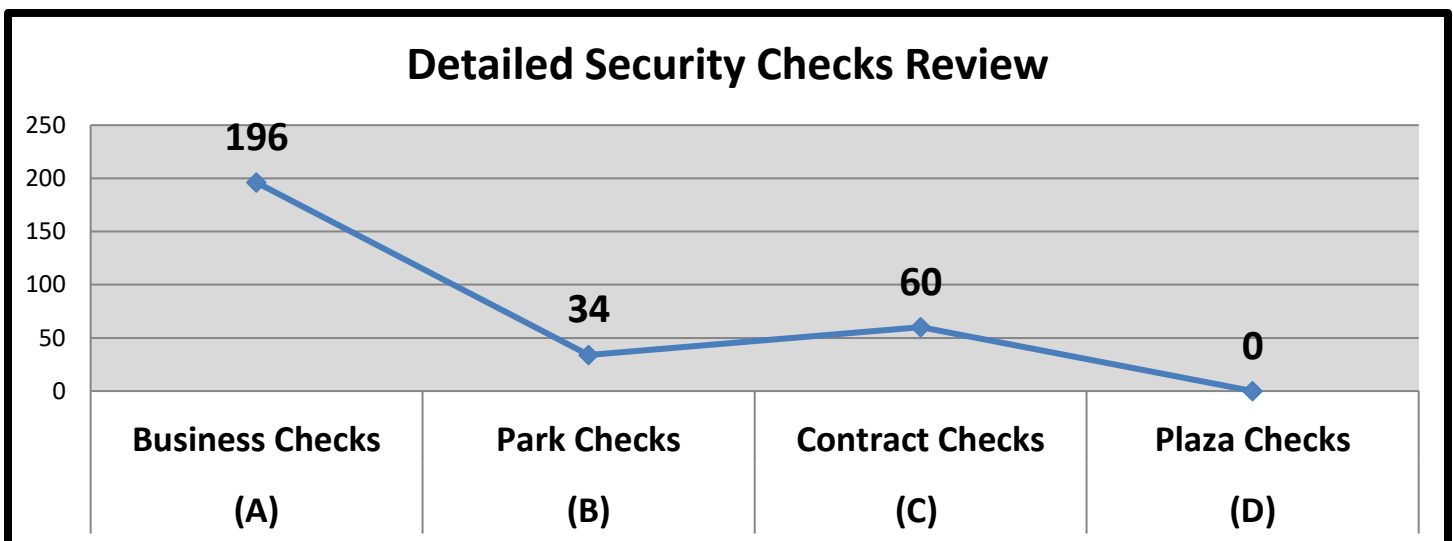

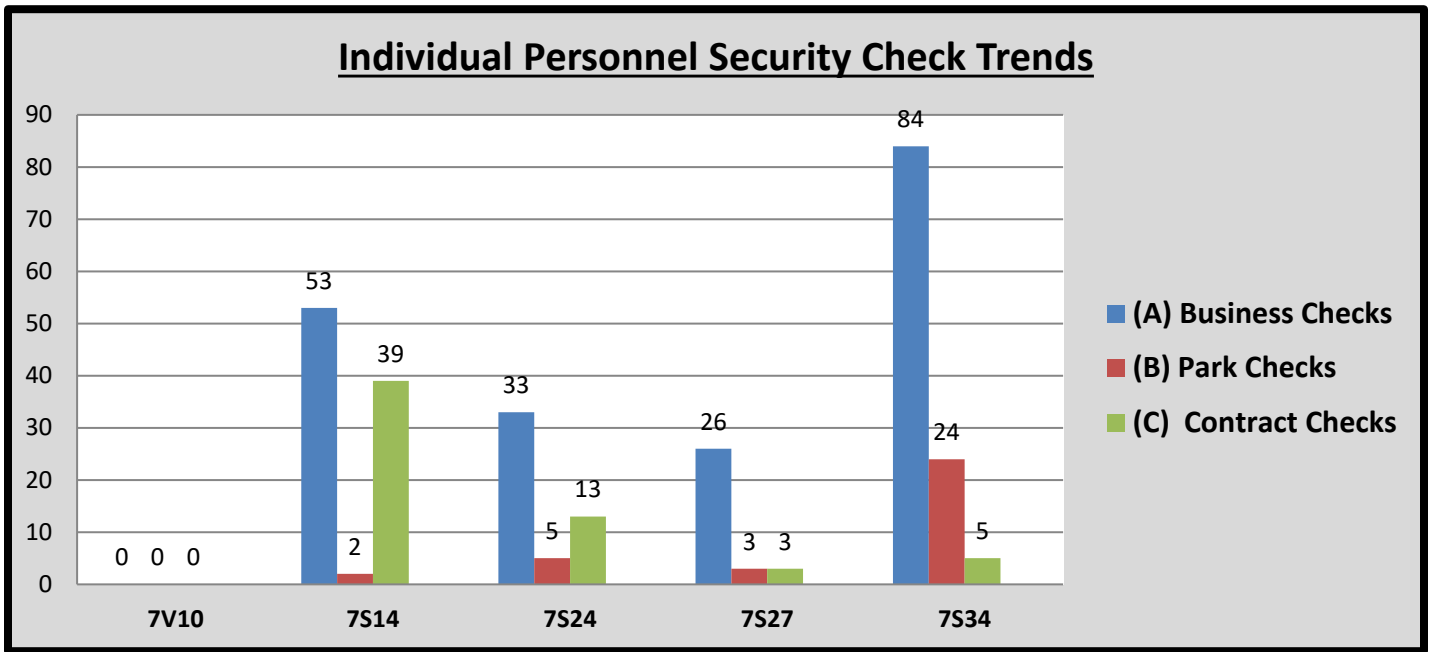

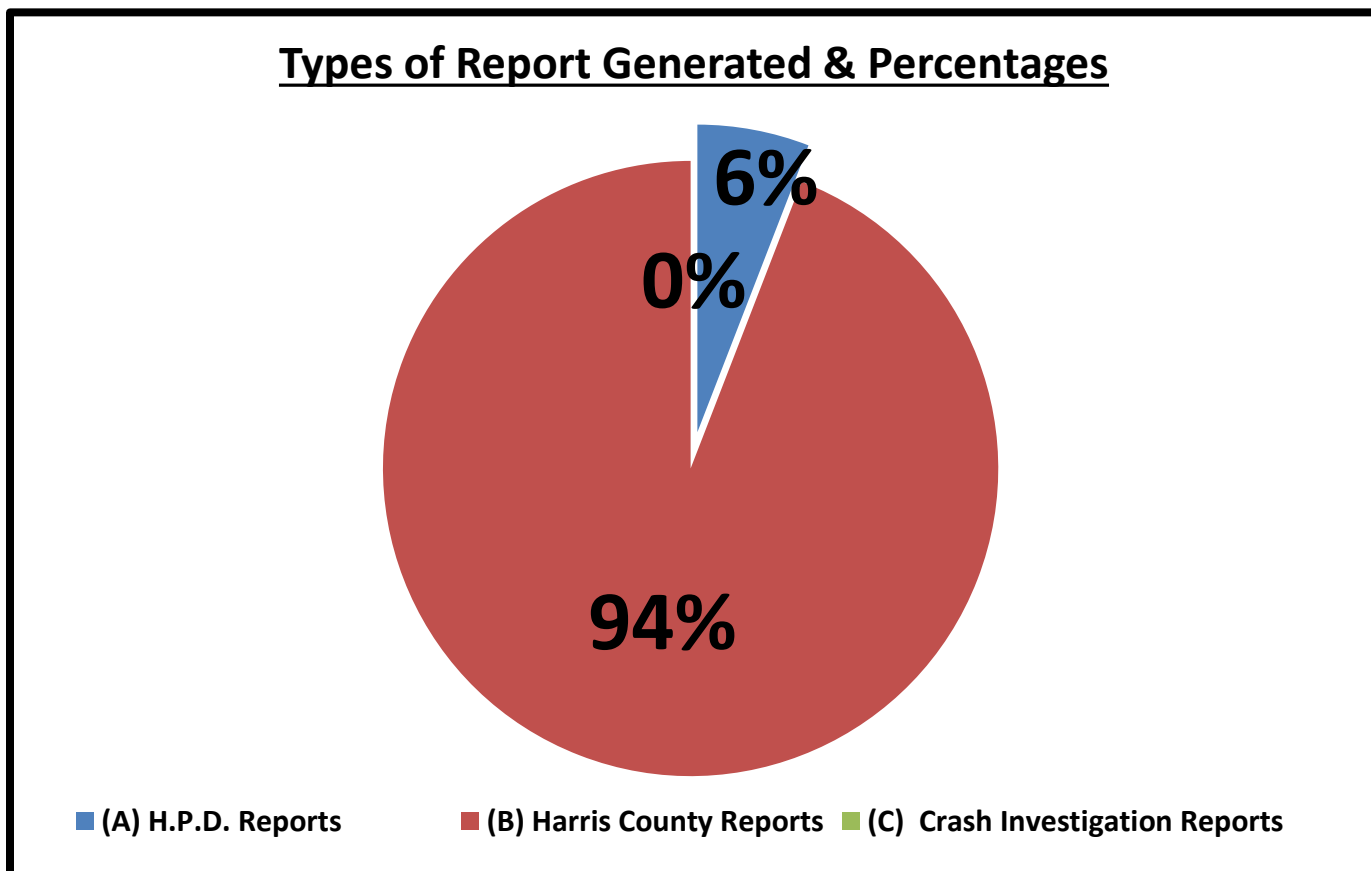

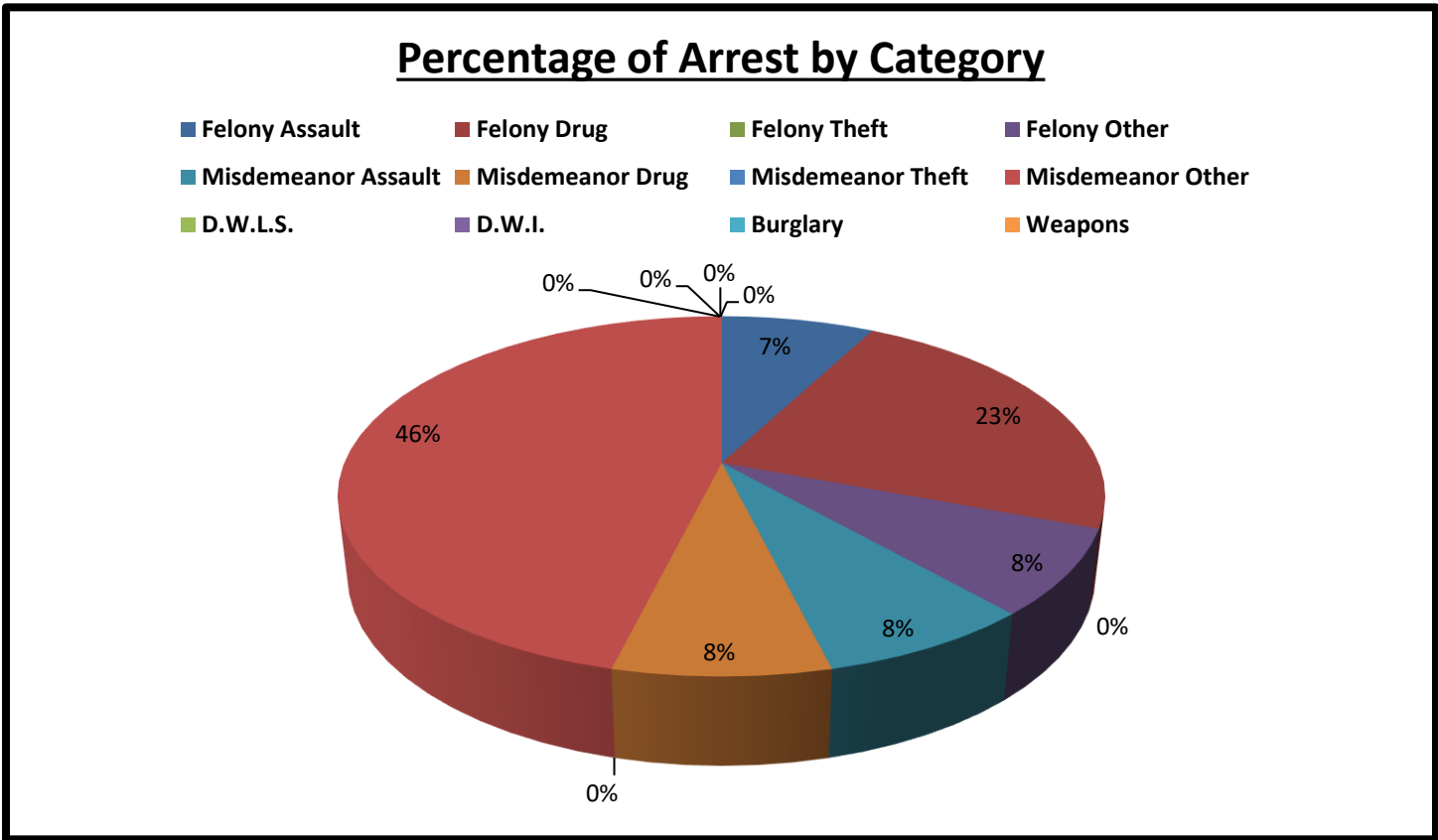

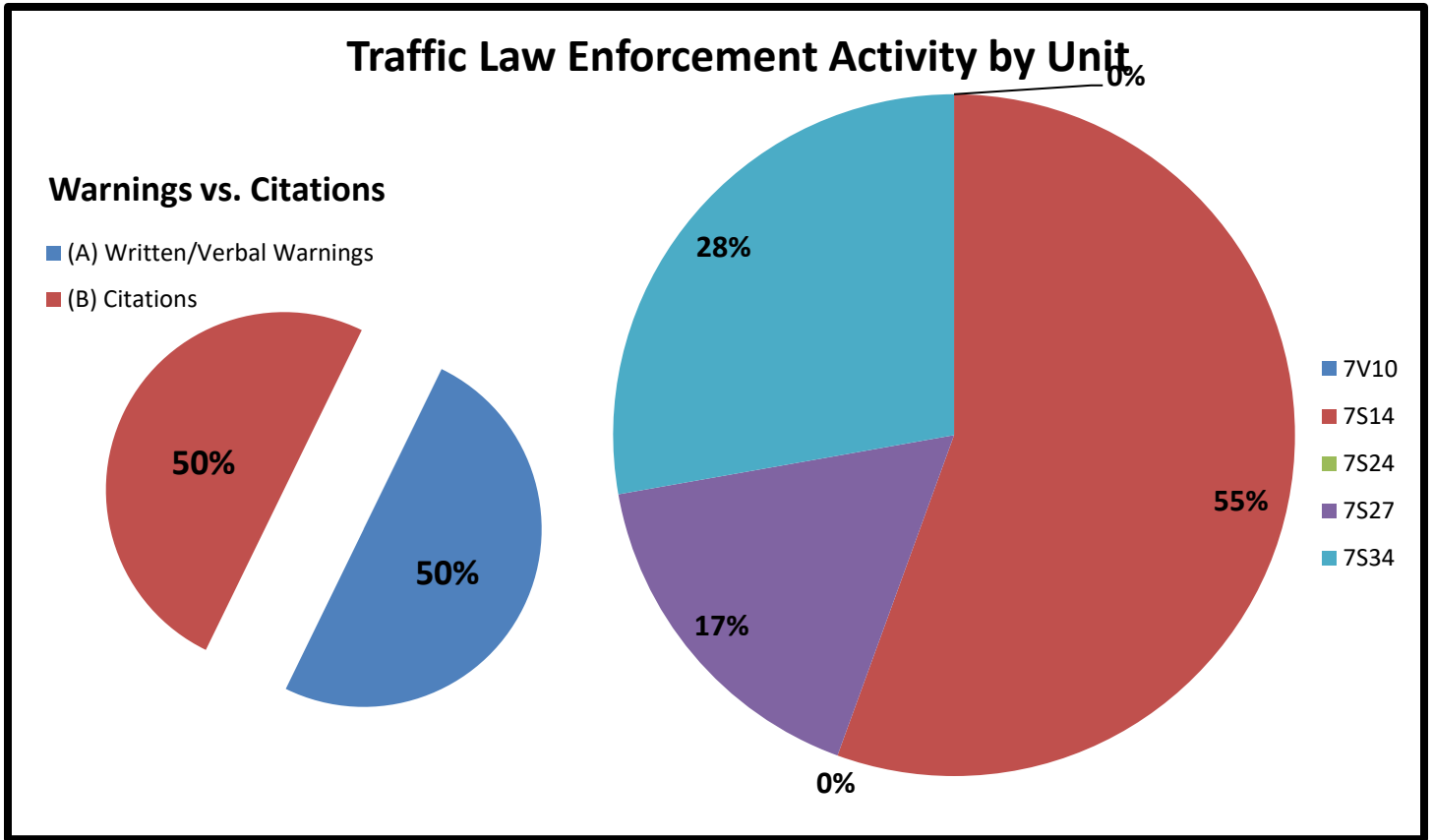

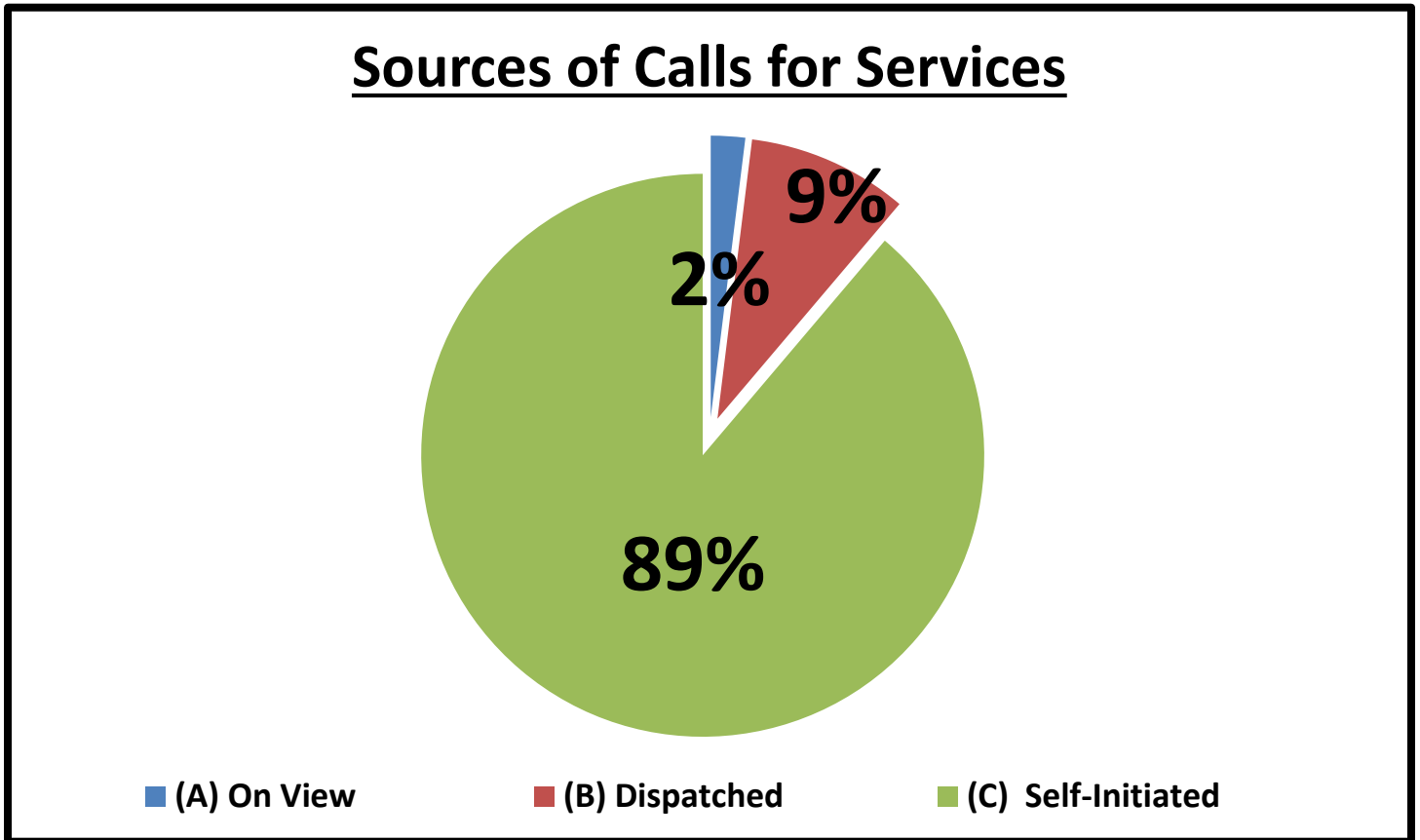

The male was deemed a danger to himself and/or others. He was then transported to NPC where he was refused and then was transported to Memorial Hermann for medical evaluation. I then generated a County Report. The patrol activity type is "PAT=D".</p>
