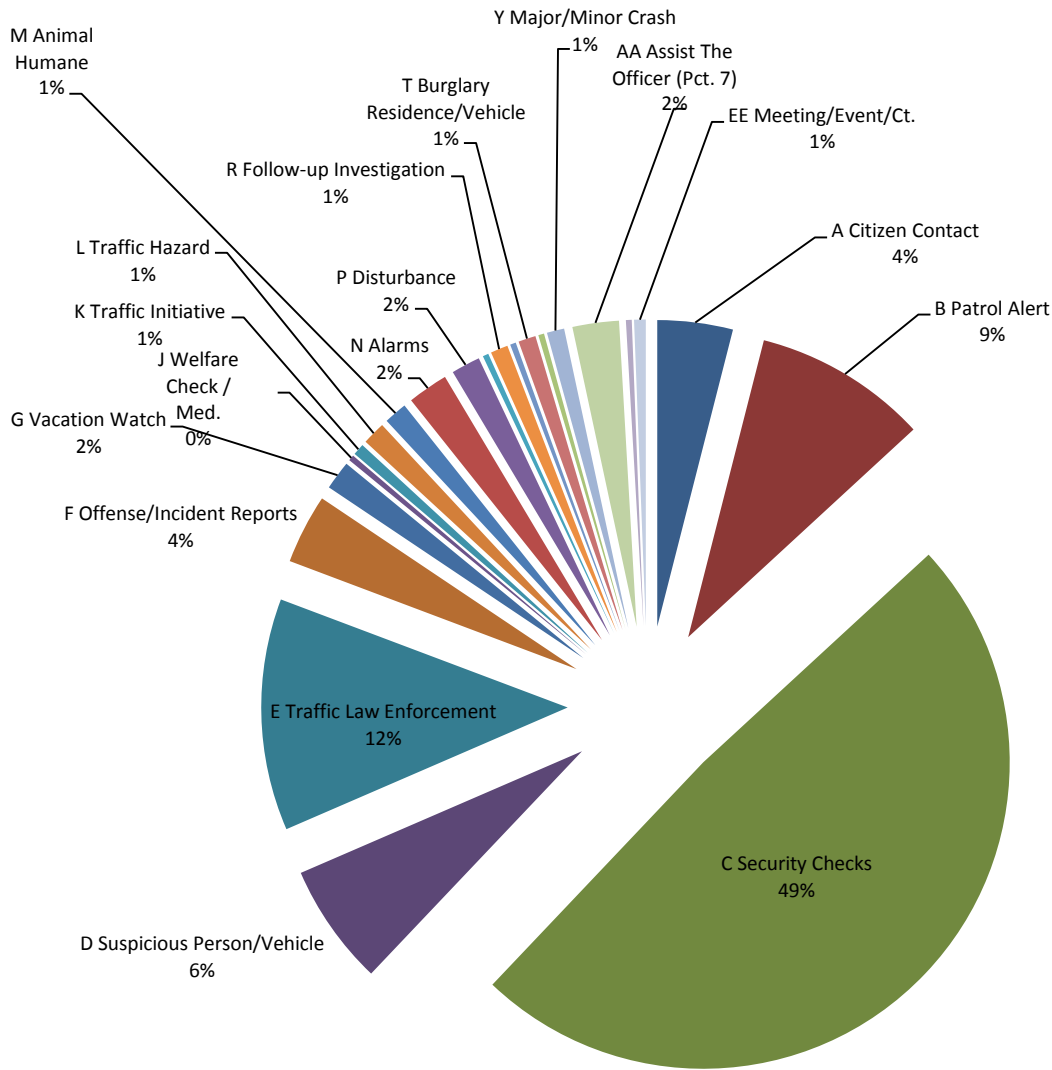

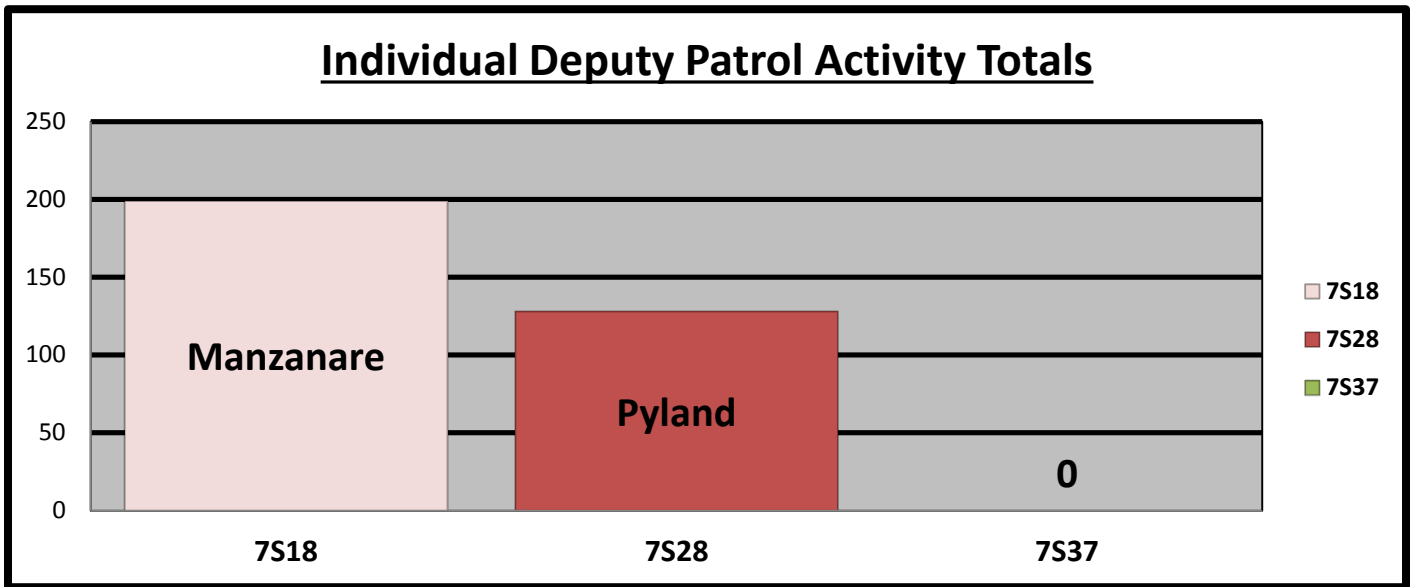
A1. Patrol Activity Percentage:

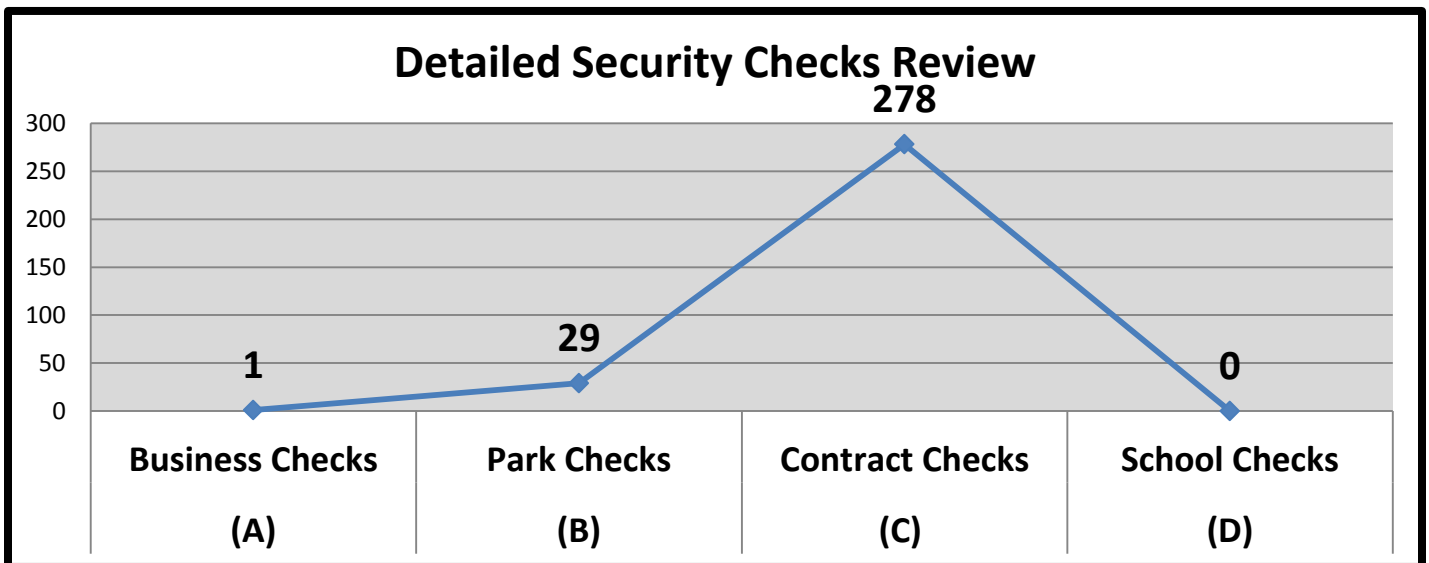

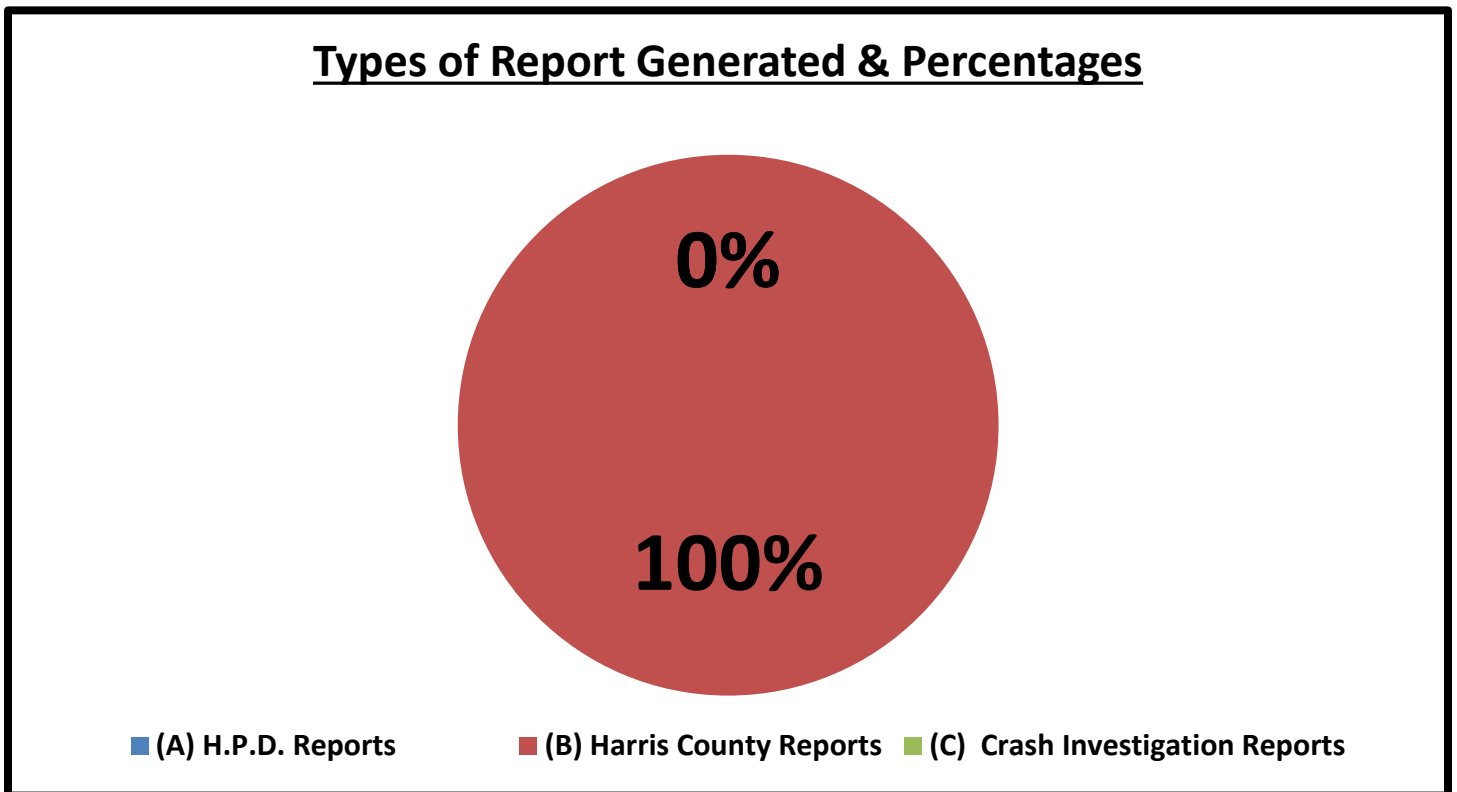

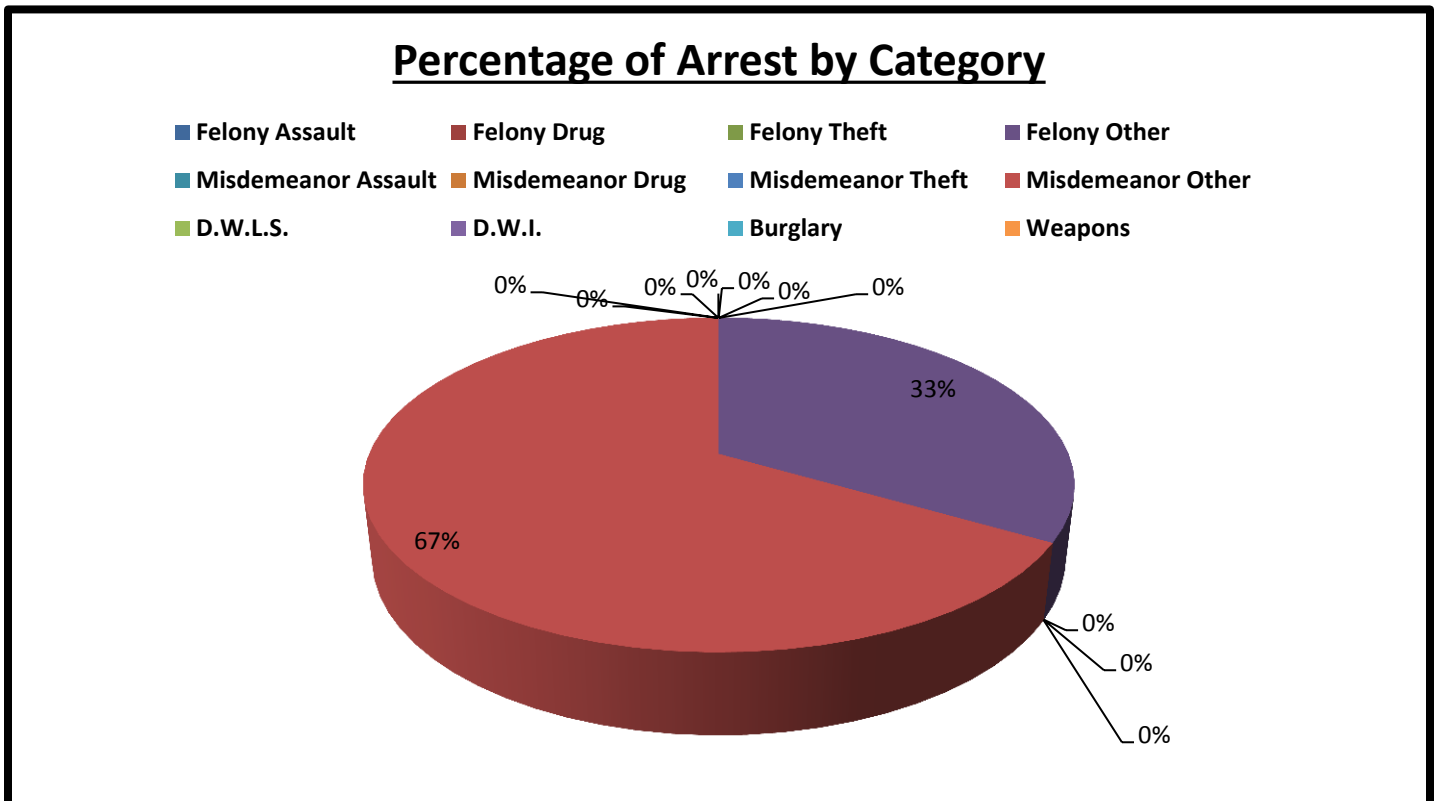
K. Types of Criminal Arrests Monthly Total:

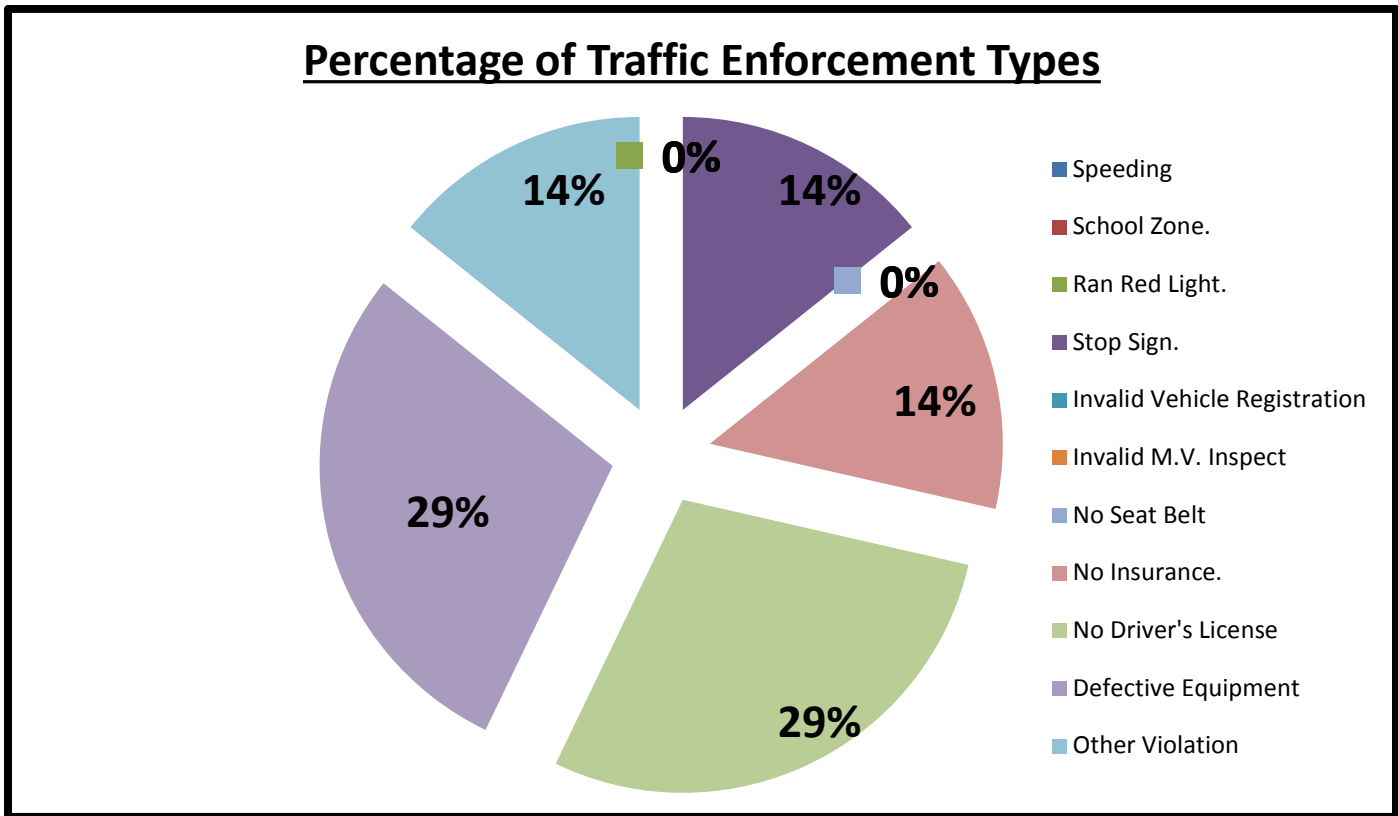

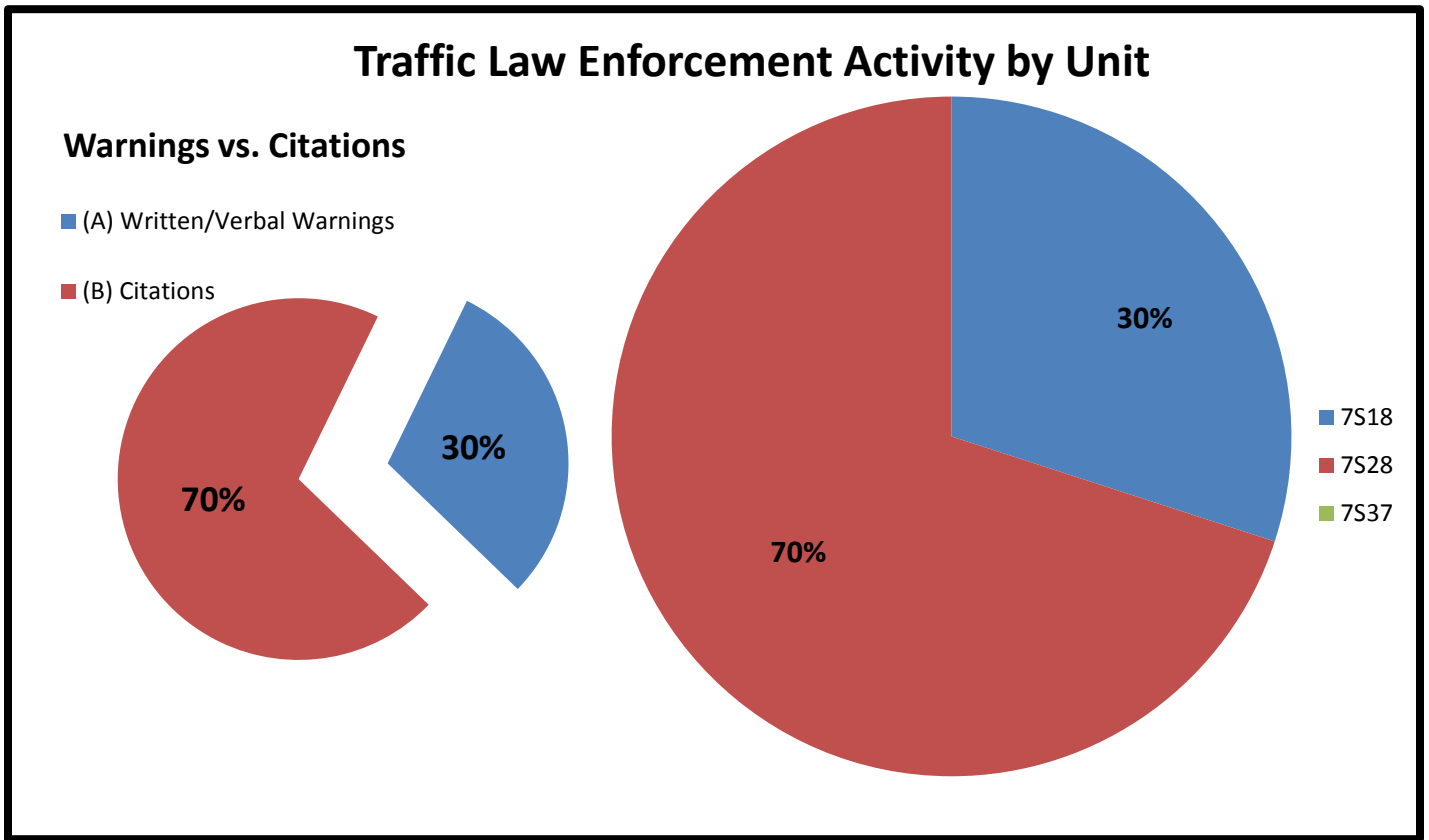

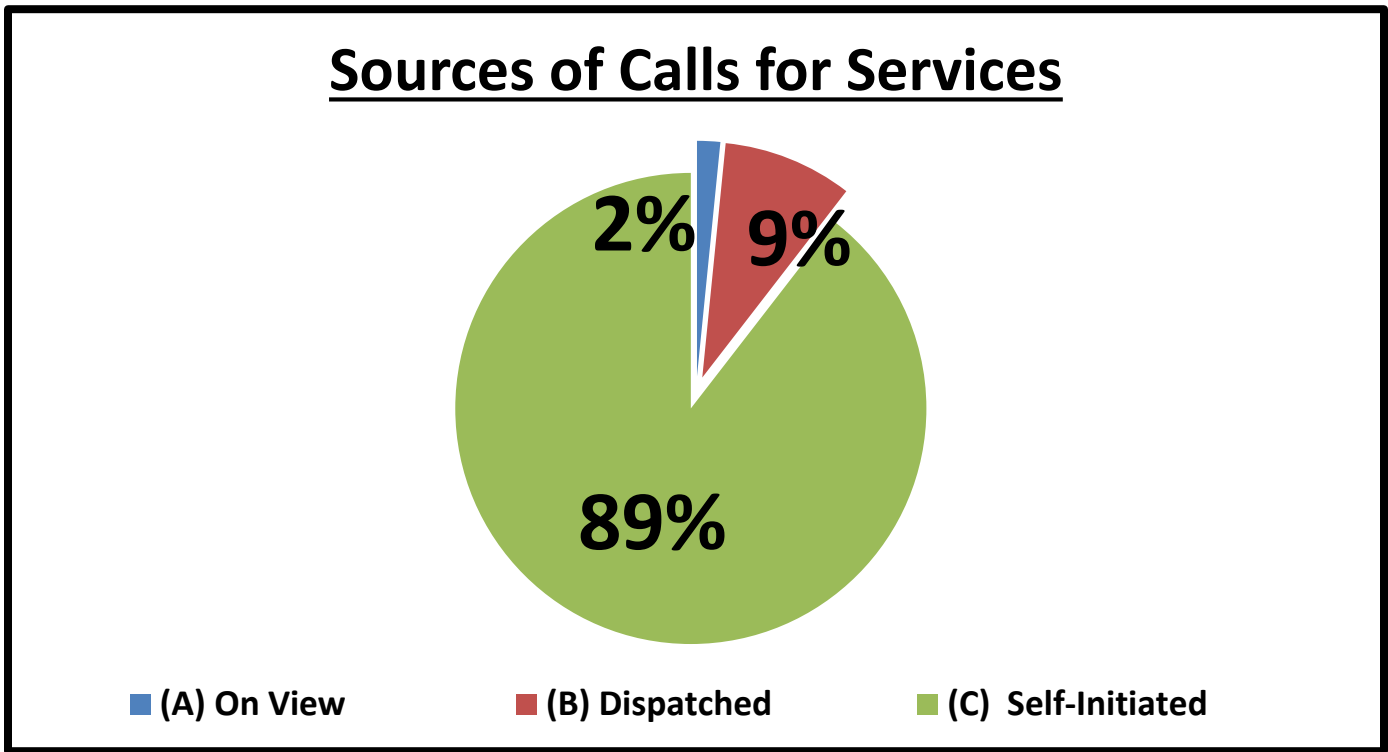
S. Traffic Law Enforcement Activity by Unit Percentages:
