Specifically, for Patrol Deputies and Patrol Sergeants, this course presents an in-depth critical analysis of the past and present evolutions of Arrest, Search, and Seizure jurisprudence, case law, and relevant statutes. If at the end of the course the student's collected/recovered evidence is suppressed, the student will not successfully pass this course.

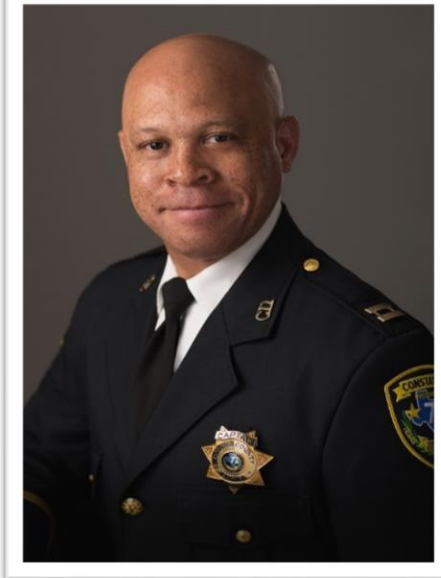

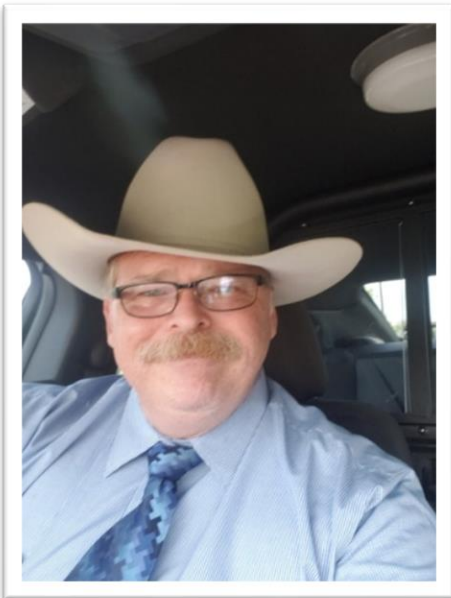
## A Short Biography of Captain Holland Jones and Instructor Richard “Rick” White
